 & her saddle and all the deeper furniture & her bed &
 furniture & my walnut Chest & Cupboard & a large
 Looking Glass and a tea kettle & the whole and other
 useful to be Equally divided between Jennat & Henry
 and my big wheel & spinning wheel & red & blue
 Soothing Irons I give & bequeath to my Beloved
 Son Henry M^r Henry my two negro boys Bell & Gels
 my Waggon & Gears & all plantation utensils & grain
 Stone and all Horse Carters that are wanted & walnut
 Table & Stoppan Chest and the Cow Creters and
 all the other thing not Marked in the House
 to be Equally Divided between Jennat & Henry
 Except the Bed & furniture had a long
 time before.

Lastly I name ordain & appoint my Beloved Son
 & Henry M^r Henry my Executors of then my Last will
 & Testament hereby Revoking disannulling all former
 & other Wills Testaments Legacies Bequests & Executors
 by me before this time named Relieving and Con-
 firming them & no other to be my Last will & Testa-
 ment Signed Sealed published pronounced and delivered
 by Me J^r Henry M^r Henry as last will & Testa-
 ment in presence
 of us the subscribers

In the following manner that is to say -
In the first place I will that all my Lawful debts be paid & that a tract of Land containing two Hundred Acres joining the tract of Land Snow Lake on be sold for that purpose I give to my Beloved wife Elizabeth all that Marriage or Linement of Land Land whereon Snow Lake during her life or widowhood and at her death or marriage I will that the same be sold and the money arising from said sale be divided as follows (Viz) to each of my daughters ten pounds and the remaining part of the money to be divided among all my Sons and in case it should be agreed on during his life or widowhood to all said lands. I Will that my wife have the one third of the Money arising from said sale and the remaining part to be divided among my Children as above mentioned Also I give to my wife during his life or widowhood my Negro fellow Peter and my Negro Muck Sylla and at her Death or Marriage I will that they be sold and the money to be equally divided among all my Sons also I give unto my wife my household furniture horses Cattle and other stock and my plantation Tools to be kept on the place for the support of herself and family. Also I give to my Daughter Susan my Negro Nell. Also I give to my Daughter Sarah my Negro Dinah. Also I give to my Daughter Margaret
