Neely of the State of N Carolina & County of Rowan, being in health of body & perfect mind & memory, thanks be given unto God calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & testament that is to say, Principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it, & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise & dispose of the same in following manner & form.
First I give & bequeath to each of my well beloved

grand children, to each & every one of the named John give paid when they arrive to the age of twenty one years.

Second I give to my well beloved grand Daughter Elleanor Hall a bed & furniture, now standing on the left.

Third I give to my well beloved son Alexander M. Neely a negro wench named Ester.

Also I give to my well beloved son Samuel M. Neely all & singular my lands messuages & tenements by him freely to be possessed & enjoyed, he paying my lawfull debts.

I likewise constitute make & ordain my well beloved sons John & Samuel M. Neely executors of this my last will & testament; And I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke & disannul all & every other testament, ~~and~~ ^{and} legacies utterly disavow bequeaths & executors by me in any wise named, willed, & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty second day of February A.D. 1800.
