manner & form, viz.

It is my will & pleasure, that all those just debts or duties
which I owe to any person or persons whomsoever, either in
right or conscience, to be truly paid & satisfied at some con-
venient time after my decease by my executors

Item I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Sarah Jackson
all my estate, goods & chattels, my out standing debts & owe-
thing that is mine to her own proper use & behoof for ever

Lastly I name, ordain, appoint & constitute my beloved wife
Sarah Jackson & her brother Isaac Cowan to execute this my
last will & test: hereby revoking & disannulling all former
wills, bequeaths, demises & executors, by me in any manner
of ways before this time, named, willed, bequeathed or
appointed; ratifying this & no other to be my last will
test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand &
seal the day & year above written.

In the name of God Amen! I, John Phillips of
Rowan County & State of N. Carolina, being well in
& sound mind & memory thanks be to God, do make & or-
dain this to be my last will & test: in manner & form following
that is to say.

1/ I leave unto my beloved wife the use of my whole
bulk real & personal during the time she remains my

reserving as hereafter reserved.

It is my will & desire that in case my wife should hereafter marry, then & in that case I give & bequeath to her the sum of one hundred silver dollars & also her bed & furniture to her her heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Phillips the sum of five shillings to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath unto my son John Phillips the sum of five shillings to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Gabriel Phillips the sum of five shillings to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Ezra Phillips the sum of five shillings to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Jonathan Phillips the sum of forty pounds currency of this State to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my son Robert Phillips the sum of five pounds to him his heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Bugday the sum of five shillings to her her heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Ruth Jones the sum of five shillings to her her heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Viny the sum of five shillings to her her heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Ann Cummins the sum of forty shillings currency, of the state, to her her heirs & assigns forever.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Rebecca Williams the sum of forty shillings to her her heirs & assigns forever.

And I give & bequeath to my three sons (to wit) James, Elijah & Stephen Phillips, the whole of my lands to be equally divided between them in quality & quantity at the death or marriage of my wife aforesaid to them their heirs & assigns forever reserving as hereafter reserved.

13. I give & bequeath unto my four children (to wit) my daughter Mary Phillips, James, Elijah & Stephen Phillips the whole of the remainder or balance of my personal estate after the legacies above & before named being paid out by my executors hereafter named to be equally divided with the increase thereof between them, to them their heirs & assigns forever at the death or marriage of my wife aforesaid reserving as hereafter reserved.

It is my will & desire, that either of my three sons aforesaid (to wit) James Elijah & Stephen Phillips should die before the arrive to the age of twenty one years old, without having lawful living issue that then & in that case I give & bequeath their part or share of my land to the survivors to them their heirs & assigns forever.

It is my will & desire that if either of my four children (to wit) my daughter Mary Phillips & my three sons James Elijah & Stephen Phillips, should die before they arrive to the age of twenty one years old or married, that what I have given them of my personal estate that then & in that case I give & bequeath their part or share to be equally divided between them as specified in this clause at the death or marriage of my wife.

It is further my will & desire that my four children (to wit) Mary, Philipos, James, Elizabeth & Stephen Philipos, be directly supported & schooled out of the profits of my estate which I reserve out of the use of my estate as before mentioned to my wife.

And I hereby make & ordain my beloved wife Diannah Philipos & my friend Lewis Hicks my executors of this my last will & test: In witness whereof I the said John Philipos have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal this day of November 1800.

The will & test: of a sick man yet in perfect mind & memory. First & foremost I give my soul to God who gave it to me, & my body to the earth, to be buried after a christian manner, & all my just debts to be paid there & therefore I give unto my brother Abel Batley a tract of land, that my brother John Batley.

Likewise I give to my father one gray horse & a stable with, then & there & therefore, all the rest of my estate & moveables to be divided between my two brothers & sister every one to have & to hold one equal share, Given under my hand & seal this 25th June 1764.

It is to be observed before signing or delivering I have my cousin John Armstrong at our water to be executor over all my estates & moveables.
