the Mortality of my body & that it is Appoynted for all men once to die,
to make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament Principally &

first of all I give and Recommand my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God
that gave it me and my body Recommand to the to be Buried in a Durn
and Christian like manner at the Direction of beloved Wife and friends

Nothing Doubting but the general Resurrection I shall receiveth same

The same again by the mighty power of God and at touching such

worldly Goods as it falleth to man to die to sleep me with me I give, Bemire
and Dispose of in Manner adous followeth: Item I will and Bequeath

Money due to me from Robert Wilson of a Commissioning Part of a Bond,

being Fifteen Pounds Ten Shillings Penny Invasion Money upon
Robert Roseberg Pennsylvania and also all my Bills & Accts & Creditors

One large large Chest and three Cham pote Bone Lining Washand & four
Cotton Cards and all my Powder and all my other Household Goods and etc

one Black and White Cow and Calf, and five head of Hogs, and half to
come now growing and what else there is, arch and large Bede

and the Bede is to be Delivere to her Son Thomas

Bequeath unto Beloved Son John Rutledge the Land and Improvement
whereon I now live for bid he will the sum of Money I have Indebted to
Isaac Rutledge Now living with John Scamill wher he now is
recoverable by law and if not the said Land and Improvement to be sold by the
before mentioned Captain Money to be paid out of pricke of it & the one pce
I desire that my Son John keeps for his Share to Item I give and Bequeath
unto my Son James Twenty Shillings More Money to be paid by my Executors
Item I give and Bequeath to my Beloved Daughter Susanna Severt
Shillings more to be paid as before Item I give and Bequeath unto
my Beloved Son Joseph my ploughs and Plough to him, the tracting
belonging therunto and one Blue Coat & jacket & pair of breeches & pair of
Trowsers & 2 hats & 2 pair of Stockes & Gloves and 1 smooth Rore, Gun I belong to
my Son John & 10d to Coat & jacket and 1 pair of Boots and also I give
my Son John to my Wife have Possessio[n] of the House, and further bid
till next spring Item I constitute and appoynt my Son John Rutledge my
Whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament and I do direct
and command and make void all other wills and Bequests made or done heretofore
by me. Ratifying & allowing this only to be my last Will and Testa-
ment, In witness whereof I have, hereunto set my hand and Seal this
12 Day of September 1774.

Ch. B. I will & Desire to have and therelaid of ~~Carter~~ Young Justice
to tell and the Expence of my funeral to be paid out of the sum of three
doles sealed published and pronounced in the presence of us.
