forty pounds Lawfull Money of Pennies out of my Estate and
in Liew of her Dower to be paid to her by my Executors twenty pounds
in three Months after my decease and the other Twenty pounds within
nine Months after my decease and besides at the third part of all
my moveable Estate I give and to her. Also I give unto my Son
Jacob Eight pounds Lawfull Money of Pennies as a trust bond
further to be equal share than with all my other children them are
namely Richard Henry Magdalene & Anna Magdalene Elizabeth all
this are to have equal Shares of all the Overplus of my Estate
whatever real and personal Estate when my dear Wife

receiveth the same I made over to her as aforesaid and my Son Jacob
receiveth the abovesaid eight pounds than all the rest shall be equally
divided in equal Shares amongst my Children above named
and do further nominate & appoint my Son Jacob Hulley and
my trusty and loving Friend Peter Holman sole Executrix of
this my last Will and Testament, and do also hereby revoke
and make void all other and former Wills and Testaments. At
