 Warding Estate where with is has pleased God to Bless me  
 In this life I Give demise and dispose of in following  
 Manner and form. Viz. and first I will and particularly  
 ordain that all my debts be paid I Give and Bequeath to Mary  
 my dear & beloved wife the black mare two cows and calves  
 called Chancy and pink a Linen white large Spoon set of  
 Irons blivies and a single tree and falling as one bed  
 and what ever house hold furniture she may stand  
 In need of. I Give to her and her two children until  
 June 1<sup>st</sup> 1792 the over plus to be disposed of to the highest bidder  
 the two children that I have by her each one of them to have  
 at coming to age a horse creature and cow and calf and if  
 any of the mother shall marry before the coming of age the  
 children to have and she to make God the above mentioned  
 articles after deducting what the Law allows widow, support  
 to my son Benjamin the sum of \$1000 both  
 and to my daughter Elizabeth one cow bad shot and one  
 hundred shillings. To my son Robert I will the one  
 cow and one year olds and two year olds two  
 Mark horses and what ever furniture there may be that is

not willed to be sold and what monies shall arise by the  
 or otherwise over and above what pays my debts and  
 schools the Children to be divided Equally amongst six  
 Children Viz. Elizabeth Benjamin Elizabeth Robert  
 Rachel and John and I do Rectify and confirm this and  
 no other to be my last will and testament and do  
 constitute Richard Davis to be the Executor of this my  
 last will and testament and trustee for my wife and  
 children in witness where of I have hereunto set my  
 hand and seal this 20<sup>th</sup> Day of April and in the year  
 of our Lord God 1791
