last will & Testament, that is to say, first of all

at the discretion of my executors, and as touching
such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to
bless me in this life, I give demise & dispose of the
same in the following manner & form. First I give
& bequeath to my eight children a tract of land ly-
ing on Bear creek containing five hundred acres
be it more or less & that to be equally divided among
them at the discretion of my ~~Executors~~ ^{Children}. Also I give
to my well beloved children above mentioned a
tract of land lying & being in Collier County in
Rowan River known by the name of the Longbottom
containing three hundred acres more or less to be
likewise divided at the discretion of my Executors.
Likewise I give the land & plantation wherewith
now live to my well beloved children above men-
tioned being two hundred & fifty acres to be di-
vided amongst them all at the discretion of my
Ex^{rs}. I also desire that all the rest of my Estate

should be sold by Ex^{rs} if the revenue for as it be given
divided amongst my eight children above mentioned
My children being, David Willcox, George Willcox
son, John Willcox, Elizabeth Willcox, Mary Willcox,
William Willcox, James Willcox, & John Willcox. I also
desire that my book accounts should be examined by
my Executors, and that money with what I have in
hand and what is due me by note, should be bestowed on my
five youngest children in schooling and other necessities
only one half for each and that I give to my beloved brother
John Willcoxson Jr. I constitute & ordain my beloved son
John Willcoxson and David my beloved son the Executors
of this my last will & Testament. In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty first day
of June one thousand four hundred & eighty five.

Currency of the State And in the next I give &
bequeath unto my beloved Sister Elisabeth Wife
to Robert McClelland of Shroton Hill, County Tippe-
rary in the Kingdom of Ireland all the remain-
ing part of my Estate. Which Legacies above men-
tioned except Martha Parke must be paid laid
out in Tobacco or flanneled as fast as the can
be collected & given into the hands of some of
the Merchants of Fayetteville for them to consign
them by way of their Friends in Ireland or Scot-
land to my Father John Hazlett in the Town of
Tipperary Munster Kingdom of Ireland for him
to distribute to them in what manner he sees
fit & for him to keep any part or parcel of said
Legacies in his own hands for his use and my
Mothers use if they stand in need of it. I desire
that all my real & personal Estate be sold at
public Vendue & that Twelve months be given

for paym^t out of the money. I do desire that ^{part} ~~part~~ of my Estate is found in my hands after my decease
that my honest debts be immediately paid and the remain-
der be immediately shipped off to my friends in Ireland
and as fast as the Executors collect in the debts that
be sent year by year also untill the whole is dis-
charged. And lastly I do hereby constitute &
appoint my beloved friends James Daniel Esq^r
of Rowan County, Vtate aforesaid and William
McGriger Baptist preacher of Mountgomery Coun-
ty and State aforesaid whole & sole Executors of this
my last will & Testament in witness whereof I do
hereby set my hand & seal this 17th day of May
