be sold by the Executor and equally to be divided among  
all my Children above named, and do constitute &  
appoint my Son Zachariah Iacob my whole sole  
Executor of this my last Will and Testament and  
do revoke disannul and make void all other Wills by  
me hitherto made in writing whereof I have here-  
unto set my hand and seal this 10 day of March  
Anno Domini 1781. Signed sealed Acknowledged

day of February One thousand seven hundred Eighty  
and three that I John Henderson of the State of North  
Carolina and County of Rowan being sick and  
weak in body but of perfect mind and memory  
thank be to God for his mercies calling to mind the  
mortality of my body, knowing that it is appoin-  
ted for all men once to die I do recommend my  
soul into the hands of God who gave it, and my  
body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like  
and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors  
and as touching such temporal Estate as it hath pertain-  
ed God to bless me with in this life, I do order in the  
following manner and form first of all I do order  
that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid  
and satisfied, ~~1781~~ it is my will and I  
do order my beloved wife Mary a Horse saddle &  
Bridle on feather Bed and it furniture forever  
and my plantation and all my moveable Estate  
during her widowhood, and keep my family to  
gether until raised and schools and of such age  
as shall be convenient to be put to trade, and  
each one to have the Trade he pleases to choose

and each one of my Sons to have a Horse and Saddle  
when he comes to the age of 21 Years if my Executors  
judge the Horse so given be no detriment to the carrying  
on the farm for the support of my Widow and younger  
Children. ~~After~~ It is my will and I doe that when my  
Youngest Child living comes to age that then my Es-  
tate not before willed be sold and one third part thereof  
be given to my Wife if then living a Widow, the remain-  
ing two thirds to be equally divided among all my  
Children at their Death. ~~After~~ It is my will that the  
one third before willed to my Widow at her Death or  
Marriage shall also be equally divided among my  
Children and that my Widow do oblige herself not to  
Waste it alienate it or make it away by gift to any  
~~After~~ it is my will and I do order my friends Harry  
Houston & William Pitt to be my joint Executors of this  
my last Will and Testament ratifying and confirming  
this and me other to be my last Will and Testament

our Lord One thousand seven hundred and seventy six  
make and constitute this my last Will and Testament in  
manner and form following, and first I most humbly

cious acceptance of it, through the all sufficient merits  
and mediation of Jesus Christ my Lord and Saviour,  
and my body to the Earth from whence it came in  
the hope of a joyful Resurrection, and thro the merciful

full debts be justly paid, and I do give and bequeath  
to my beloved and only son John my property of land  
lying between the forks of Catawba River on Little Creek  
and if he decease before he be of age, then said land to be-  
come the property of my well beloved and only daughter  
Elizabeth and I bequeath to my honoured Father John  
Lawrence my Negro Wench named Coombs to pay  
the sum of Eighty five pounds p[er] Anno of North  
Carolina.
