

to my son Peter, to be laid off all along the east side of the said line of the old deeded tract of land whereon I now live, & the plantation whereon I now live, I give with & bequeath to my son Philip & containing one hundred & fifty three acres of land & a half acre, after my son Peter has fifty three & a half acres' lade of the said tract of land on the east side of Saunders fork, the said tract of land whereon I now live contains two hundred & seven acres of land, & for all my moveable property, notes, bonds money & all things else, that I possess, I give with & bequeath unto my daughters Mary Lanes, Margaret Lanes & Catharin to be equally divided, the whole of my moveable property & that is my will that each of my daughters should have an equal part with each other.

And for the true performance of this my last will & test. I do make, ordain, constitute & appoint my true & trusty friend David Smith Senr. & my son Leonard Kern, whole & sole executors of this my last will & test: given unto them a full power to do & performe the several articles & thing herein mentioned.

In the name of God Amen! I John Kilpatrick of the County of Rowan & State of N.C. Carolina being of perfect mind & memory. - Do this 16th day of January A.D. 1804 - make ordain & publish this my last will & test: in the following manner Viz.

I give & bequeath unto my affectionate wife Elizabeth the

whole of my real & personal estate exclusive of that part I shall hereafter mention to my children - her living on the place I now live on during life, & in case she should die intested, I give & bequeath her estate to be equally divided among my children.

I give to my two sons William & Robert, the whole of my land also my hand screw to be equally divided between them.

To my son Robert I give the improvement I now live on, except the north part of the old field which my son William has been used to cultivate also my waggon & gears, & at my wife's desire I give & bequeath, that he shall have my Negro named Jack.

I give & bequeath to my daughter Mary my Negro child named Elie, a horse of thirty pounds value, her saddle & bridle, three coats a good bed & bed-furniture.

I give & bequeath to my grandsons John Barr & John Foster & to my daughters Nancy, Jean, Lettice & Elizabeth, to each of them I give & bequeath five shillings sterling.

And I do nominate & appoint my two sons William & Robert to be my executors of this my last will & test: And I do hereby disannull all former wills & ratify & confirm this to be my last will & test: in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal, the day & year above written.
