 and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs & thereby be
 the better prepared to leave this world when it may
 please God to call me home do therefore make & publish
 this my last will & Testament in manner & form
 following. Item first my will & Desire is that all
 my just Debts shall be paid out of my personal Estate
 Item Secondly I give & Bequeath unto my beloved Wife
 Margaret Pain one third part of all I possess during her
 life Item Thirdly I give & Bequeath unto my Beloved

shipped Kappor. I Bequeath to Sarah my Beloved Daughter
the one half of the Ready money I possess not yet
Bequeathed & all legal demands due & to be due likewise one
half of the Rented Cattle not yet Bequeathed and half of the
stock & provisions and all other household necessaries to be
divided at the discretion of my Executors between the said
Mary & Margaret hereafter to be mentioned. I Bequeath to Margaret
my Beloved Daughter the other half of the Rented Cattle & stock
above mentioned likewise the other half of my Ready money as afore-
said with a part of all my household furniture my Black gown
& my Kitt to be given at the discretion of my Executors I Bequeath
to my son Andrew daughter Mary my saddle and a canton apron I
Bequeath to my son James daughter Elizabeth one Red Kappor
And do by this present constitute appoint & ordain my sons the said
Andrew & James my Executors of this my last will & Testament & do hereby revoke & disannul all
other wills & Testaments I Bequeath & confirm this only to be my last will
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
& Eighty four.
