And I do constitute make & ordain my well beloved wife Margaret & my trusty brother Israel Whitaker, executors of this my last will & testament & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all other former wills & testament by me made either in writing or any other way, ratifying & confirming this to no other to be my last will & test. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 8<sup>th</sup> of Decbr. AD 1799.

I John Wilson son, being of sound & disposing mind in memory do make this my last will & testament. I give to my son John Wilson all my lands & tenements to him & his heirs forever except one hundred acres of land beginning at the stake of Stom bush twenty rods east of Pasture bush comes thence running south so far as to include one hundred acres of land running a line parallel with Pasture bush line which hundred acres is to include the cleared lands & buildings made by my son Wilson, which one hundred acres of land I give to my grandson Andrew Wilson son of my son John Wilson his heirs & posterity ever.

My will & pleasure is further that my son John Wilson pay to my son James Wilson the sum of fifty pounds current money in part as a consideration of the devise to him that he

I give to my son the said John the following negroes to wit Ben, his wife Black, their children, P.M., George, Dicey & Darcy, with their increase as I have heretofore given said negroes to him the said John Wilson by law I also give him the said John my wagon & two horses called Dick & Black with their gear also all my plantation tools also my distill & tubs.

I give unto my daughter Mary Boone one feather bed & furniture also to my daughter Elizabeth Frost one bed & furniture also to my daughter in case wife of John Wilson one bed & furniture.

I also give to William Hunter & his representatives by my daughter Rachael the sum of five shillings & money.

My will & further pleasure is that all my personal estate that is not herein devised shall be sold by my executors & the amount thereof together with all my outstanding debts to be equally divided between my children James Wilson, Elizabeth Frost, Mary Boone, Samuel Wilson & Sarah Harper, of this part of my estate my son John is to have no part.

I also give to Ebenezer Frost a negro named Tom Wilson now in his possession. I appoint my son John Wilson & Spruce Macy his co-executors of this my last

In the name of God Amen! I George Wrightman  
of Rowan County in the State of N Carolina being very  
weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thank's be given  
to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing  
that it is appointed for all men once to die do make  
and ordain this my last will & testament, That is to say prior  
especially & first of I give & recommend my soul into the hand  
of almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to  
the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the  
discretion of my executors, nothing doubting but at the  
general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the  
mighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate  
wherewith it had pleased God to bless me with it in this life  
I give devise & dispose of the same in following manner:  
First it is my will that all my just debts be paid out of  
my moveable effects - Then I give & bequeath unto my  
dearly beloved wife Mary Wrightman & young son Jacob  
Wrightman one hundred acres of land of the north end of

of my homestead place adjoining the marian line to  
thick thorn hirs & signs for ever. I then give & bequeath  
to my three daughters Mary Elizabeth & Rachel Wrightman  
the remainder part of my homestead place of sixty acres  
including my Improvement to be equally divided between  
them their heirs & assigns forever provided, nevertheless  
that my wife shall have the sole privilege of my im-  
provements for two whole years after my decease &  
my daughters to live with her if they choose during the  
said term of time.

I then give & bequeath to my three daughters Mary  
Elizabeth & Rachel Wrightman to each of them one feather  
bed & furniture as they now claim them - I then give &  
bequeath to my wife & son such of them a bed.

I desire then that my debts be paid out of my moveable  
property as aforesaid & the remainder part to be equally  
divided between my wife & children.

I do hereby constitute & appoint my wife Mary  
Wrightman & my daughter Mary Wrightman my executors  
of this my last will & testament. And do hereby utterly  
disabuse revoke & disannul all & every other former will  
by me made, in witness whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand & seal this 2d day of January AD 1798.
