constitute & appoint my trusty Friends James Garson &
my beloved Sons George Smith & Richard Watton Executors
of this my last Will & Testament hereby revoking & re-
voking & making void all former Wills be made testifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last Will &
Testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand & Seal this nineteenth Day of September 1767.
