Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thank be given to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & test: that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of allmighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again through the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give, & dispose of the same in following manner.

I give & bequeath to my son Job Little five shillings.
 Then I give & bequeath to my son Reuben Little five shillings
 Then I give & bequeath to my son Jonas Little five shillings
 I give & bequeath to my son in law Jacob Brunet five shillings
 I give & bequeath to my son in law Reuben Charles five shillings
 I give & bequeath to my daughter Nancy Little five shillings.
 I give & bequeath to my son Samuel Little five shillings & one bay horse. I then give & bequeath to my son William Little, one black two year old colt. I then give & bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Margaret Little all & singular the rest of my estate both real & moveable to be at her disposal to be used in the best manner, that she shall think proper, for the support of herself & the youngest children. I then give & bequeath to my son Ezekiel Little, when he comes of age to have Eight pounds & Rebecca Little & Sarah Little my daughters five shillings each. I do hereby constitute & ordain my loving wife Margaret Little my sole executor of this my last will & test: and I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all & every other former wills or test: made by me in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifteenth day of March A.D. 1797.
