1803.

the cost of proving this my last will & test: be first paid
out of my estate by my executors hereafter mentioned.

I give & bequeath unto my brother Samuel McConaughy
one hundred Dollars to be paid him in yearly payments of
ten Dollars per year until he receives the whole one hundred Dollars.

I give & bequeath & devise unto my loving brother James
McConaughy all the rest of my estate what ever, both
real & personal at his own free will & disposal.

Lastly I nominate constitute & appoint my brother
James McConaughy executor of this my last will &
testament hereby revoking all other wills, executors heretofore
by me made, nominated or appointed hereby ratifying &
confirming this as my last will & test: & this only. In
testimony of which I have set my hand & affixed my seal
this 10. Day of January A.D. 1804.
