Also the remainder of my Estate it is my will that it shall be equally divided between my son John Smith and my daughters Anne Wollen, Elizabeth Hunt & Mary Earnest and the three Children that Richard Lewis wife had by John Ford to have one share divided amongst the three that is a share equal to the rest of my daughters.

Also I do appoint my son Moses Smith and Richard Wollen whom I make & ordain the sole Executors of my last will & Test. in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 21st Day of March in the year of our Lord 1800 signed in the presence of us

First give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Studer all my personal Estate that will remain after paying the legacies hereinafter to be named together with the use and pleasurable possession of all my lands and Tenements during her life time.

I give and bequeath to my beloved son Isaac Studer all my land and Tenements after the death of my beloved wife Elizabeth Studer and one Dollar to be paid on demand I give to my beloved daughter Polly Studer one Dollar. I give to my beloved daughter Nancy Wilton one Dollar I give to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Brookshen one Dollar I give to my beloved daughter Charly M. Clary one Dollar and I hereby make and ordain my dearly beloved wife Elizabeth Studer Execut. and my beloved son Isaac Studer Executor of this my last will and testament. For witness whereof I the said Henry Studer have to this my last will and testament set my hand and seal this day on year above written.
