In the Name of God Amen April 14th 1803
I Joseph Curingham of the County of Rowan & State
of North Carolina Yeoman Calling to mind that it is ap-
pointed for all men Once to die being very weak in body
but of perfect Mind and Memory, I do make publish, and
pronounce this my last will & Testament. First I recommend
my soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body
to be buried in a christian like manner at the direction
of my Executors nothing doubting but I shall receive the
same again at the general resurrection by the almighty
power of God that gave it - and as touching such worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this life. I give with & bequeath in the following manner
and form that is to say First I give with & bequeath to
my dearly beloved wife Mary Curingham my mansion
house and land whereon I now live with as much household
furniture as she thinks proper to keep to be possessed by
her until my son William & Joseph comes of age and then
the land to be equally divided, between my two sons, but they
are to allow her a sufficient maintenance of the plantation
her natural life time, and also as many of the cattle, hogs
& hogs as she think sufficient for, to support her and
the children, and also one Bane Mare & black horse with
as many of my plantation tools as may be considered
* sufficient to tend the plantation with.
Secondly I give with and bequeath unto Sarah Brady one cow
& calf and five pounds in money to be paid out of my Estate
as soon as she comes to age.

Thirdly I give will & bequeath unto Hugh Mailey the first Colt the above mentioned Horse made hat to be raised and supported as the other horses is and also One third of the profit that is raised on the plantation provided he stays and is obedient to my wife in all things until he comes
* of age.

Fourthly after the above mentioned articles is taken of my Estate the remainder to be sold and the money put out on Interest which I give & will & bequeath to my daughter Anna as soon as she is of age, except as much of the Interest which is to be collected yearly, that shall sufficient to give the children sufficient schooling.

And I do hereby ordain make constitute and appoint my dearly beloved wife Mary Cuninghame and my well beloved friend Robert Moore Executors of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby publish and pronounce this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and disavowing all former wills and Testaments by me made.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved uncle Hugh Cuninghame & my dearly beloved brother Robert Cuninghame to act in my place as Executors of my Fathers Estate. In witness where of the said Joseph Cuninghame have to this my last will and Testament have set my hand and seal the day and year above written Signed sealed published and pronounced by the said Joseph Cuninghame to be his last will & Testament in the presence of us who in his presence of each other have hereunto set our names.

I give and bequeath unto my Nephew Robert Foster all my Land and Negroes, likewise to be at his proper and sole will, and disposal for ever I then give and bequeath unto my brother John Ellis all the rest with the other moiety of personal Estate to be at his sole will and disposal forever I then give and bequeath unto my beloved sister Lucy Foster My wearing clothes & side saddle to be at her proper and sole will and disposal for ever I then give and bequeath unto my
