I Joseph Cunningham of the County of Rowan & State
of North Carolina Yeoman calling to mind that it is ap-
pointed for all men Once to die Being very weak in body
but of perfect Mind and Memory, I do make you publish, and
pronounce this my last will & Testament. First I recommend
my soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body
to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion
of my Executors nothing doubting but I shall receive the
same again at the general resurrection by the almighty
power of God that gave it. and as touching such worldly
Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this life. I give will & bequeath in the following manner
and form that is to say First I give will & bequeath to
my dearly beloved wife Mary Cunningham my mansion
House and land whereon I now live with as much household
furniture as she thinks proper to keep to be possessed by
her until my son William & Joseph comes of age and then
the land to be equally divided between my two sons, but they
are to allow her a sufficient maintenance of the plantation
for natural life time, and also as many of the cattle, sheep
& hogs as she think sufficient for, to support her and
the children, and also one Mare & Black horse with
as many of my plantation tools as may be considered
* sufficient to tend the plantation with.
Secondly I give will and bequeath unto Sarah Drady one cow
& calf and five pounds in money to be paid off of my Estate
as soon as he comes to age.

Thirdly I give will & bequeath unto Hugh Marley the
first Colt the above mentioned Rose mare hat to be raised
and supported as the other horses is and also One third of
the profit that is raised on the plantation provided he stays
and is obedient to my wife in all things until he comes
of age.

Fourthly after the above mentioned articles is taken of my
Estate the remainder to be sold and the money paid out on charges
which I give will & bequeath to my daughter Anna as
soon as she is of age, except as much of the Interest which
is to be collected yearly, that shall sufficient to give the
children sufficient shooting.

And I do hereby ordain make constitute and appoint
my dearly beloved wife Mary Cunningham and my well
beloved friend Robert Moore Executors of this my last
will and Testament and I do hereby publish and pronounce
this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and disannulling
all former wills and Testaments by me made.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved
uncle Hugh Cunningham & my dearly beloved brother —
Robert Cunningham to act in my place as Executors of my
Fathers Estate. In witness whereof the said Joseph
Cunningham have to this my last will and Testament
hath set my hand and seal the day and year above written
