testament that is to say ^{principally} and first of all I give and recom-
mend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my
body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian
Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubted but
at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again
by the Almighty Power of God & Touching such house hold estate
where with it has pleased God to bless me ^{in this} life I give &
dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

I do give and bequeath unto my beloved sons Moses Hull
and Joseph Hull my Mill and the Land thereunto belonging
my Son Moses to have all the Benefit of the Mill till the first
day of Aprile next ensuing this date & then to be equally
Divided between Moses Hull & Joseph Hull I do give to
my sons Moses ~~Hull~~ all my Dogges & Cattle ^{with} ~~litter~~
my Gun and as small quantity of Land in the East Gear-
ry in amwell Township I do give to my Son Joseph
my Litter bed and bedding three puter plates and a bea-
son all the rest of my Estate to be sold at Publick sale and
the Money to be Equally Divided betwixt Moses & Joseph
and if Joseph dye without heir his part of my Estate to my
grandson Joseph Hull I do give & bequeath to my Son
Daniel Hull the sum of forty pounds to be paid out
of my Estate and no more and that to be paid Ten
pounds

pounds a year I do appoint Richd an d Wilson and my
Son Moses Hull my Executors of this my last
will and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow
revok and disannull all and Every other former
wills testaments legacies & bequists and Executors by
me in any wise before named willed and bequeathed
Realizing and Confirming this and no other to be my
last will & testament in witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand and seal the day & year above written

Be it Remembred that on the twelveth day of November
1778 that Joseph Lowrance of Rowan County being
seized with a violent fit of sickness sent for one the
Subscribers and told us that he apprehended he could
not live but a very short time and signified he had
made a forf our will and testament but that it was
his will and desire to make the following alterations
It is my will and desire and do Ordain and Order that
this place I now live on shall be kept for my son
John instead of the other I willed to him & the other to be
sold and two thirds of the money to be my Son's
the other part to be my daughters I likewise order
that my Negro Wench two pound, at publick vendue
and the pound I willed to Daniel Hunt as for Mar-
the Burnett she hath gotten all her part that I willed
except her Cattle ^{are} with one yot which she
is to have and as for my wife I willed and give nothing

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We the friends of all my movable estate ^{these are}
in the beque's words of Joseph Lowrance now ^{deceased}
as witness our hands

being at this present sick and weak in body but in

therefor calling into mind the mortality of my Body
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once
to die, I do make and ordain this my last Will &
Testament That is to say Principally and first of all
I give and Recommend my soul into the Hands of
Almighty God who gave it and for my body I recom-
mend it to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like
manner at the Discretion of my Executors, nothing doub-
ting but I shall receive the same again reunited at
the general Resurrection of mankind by the mighty
Power of God and as touching such worldly Estate
Wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this

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Life I do give devise and Dispose of the same
in the following manner and form. It is my
Will and I do order that all my just debts and
funeral charges be paid out of my personal Est-
ate for which purpose I do order that my Wagon and
hind gears and gray Horse be sold at public sale &
the Proceeds there arising to be equally divided be-
tween my two youngest Daughters ^(viz) Mary and Eleanor
I do give and bequeath to my beloved son John the
third of all my land which I now possess also a plow
and furniture and gears also the third of all my Iron
Tools I do give and bequeath to my beloved
son Samuel a third of my land, also a third of all
my Iron Tools, likewise a plow and Gears and fur-
niture, also an Iron Wagon, and also his Mare
and Saddle I do give and bequeath to my
beloved son James the other third of my Land likewise
the other third of my Iron Tools also the Bar Iron
I brought to the County with me and also the young
Calf of my Black Mare and my saddle and Bri-
dle And in case that they be not able to divide the
Land and Iron Tools themselves to their satisfac-
tion, I do order and allow that two or three honest
