I do appoint & ordain George Read & Dr. Wilson executors of this my last will & test. And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannull all & every other wills legacies & bequests by me in any way before named, willed & bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day & year above written.

since the uncertain estate of this temporary life & that
all flesh shall yield unto death when it shall please God
to call: Do make, constitute & declare this my
last will & testament in manner & form following:—
Revoking & annulling by these presents all & every test:
will, heretofore by me made & declared, either by word or
writing and this only is to be taken for my last will & test:
& none other. And now for the disposal of my temporary
estate which it has been pleased God to bestow upon me I
do order, give & dispose the same in manner & form following:

Imprimis I give & bequeath the land & plantation with
the premises, containing two hundred acres to the same more
or less unto my two sons (to wit) Henry Winkler and Francis
Winkler to be equally divided between them by a dividing line
which shall run as near north & south as possible, so that
the improvements may be left on my son Henry Winkler's
part, to him & their heirs forever, Subject nevertheless
to this condition that the said Henry Winkler & Francis
Winkler my sons whom I do constitute & ordain executors
of this my last will & testament shall pay or cause to
be paid one hundred pounds unto my five beloved daughters
to wit Elizabeth Garner, Mary Peck, Catharina Ruckstull
Phoebe Rockes & Eliza Blaze, within three years after my
decease, to be equally divided among them & further that

my said two sons shall contribute to my sufficient main-
tenance & my beloved wife so long as we live in the following
manner (to wit) my son Henry shall find me two thirds and
my son Francis one third towards our said maintenance —
Utterly by the said will revoking every other gift or bequeath-
ment to be made by my ratifying & confirming this my

County of Rowan & State of N Carolina being very sick
& weak in body but of perfect mind & memory. Calling to
mind the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die. Do make & ordain this my last will
& testament, that is to say principally & first: I recommend
my soul to God & my body to the earth to be buried in a
christian & decent manner. And as touching such worldly
estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life
I give devise & dispose of in the following manners & form.
Item I give to my well beloved wife Barbara the following
articles which she shall have for her use, for the purpose
of supporting & raising my children during her widowhood
(Viz) My bed & furniture, two cows her choice of my flock

my chest & all that is therein, two Iron potts & a large Iron
kettle her spinning wheel, & dough trough & lake buckets.
fir shovel, tongs, one psalm book, eight hogs her choice of
my flock all my pewter ware of every sort, a saddle & a
horse her choice of nine all my bags three hogsheads, four
meat barrels, & all my gross of grain & forage in the Barn
& fields of what kind whatsoever all chairs & dressers, fur-
niture of every kind two ploughs & tacklings for the same
years for two horses two shays of her choice, all my axes
mattocks, spades, & shovels, & Iron wedges & mall rings all
my corn hoes, and also the use of my plantation to till
at her pleasure until my sons arrive to the age of twenty one
years, provided she remains my widow & also a plough
share & bar & all the iron & steel that I brought from
Charleston, also a smoothing Iron a copper mill & a wind
mill frying pans & Plate. My saddle all vessels tubs, and
meat tubs, sifters & riddler chunn & other copper ware,
that is necessary for her use, all flax, wool, garn, cotton
& cloths both woolen & linnen, hand saw & whatsoever
else of my goods that is necessary for her to maintain
my children & work the plantation she shall have in use
so long as she remains my widow, but so soon as she
marries another husband my plantation shall be rented
out & the above sd goods shall be sold at publick sale
of which we shall have her third part.

Item I give & bequeath unto my two sons Jacob
& Henry my plantation of land. That I live on to them
their heirs & assigns forever also my Waggon and
