my beloved son William Wiseman one Iron Hammer
I give and bequeath to Sam Wiseman my Grand daughter
one box iron and one catters. I give and bequeath to
my son James above named one spin Chat and one
buck and the big pillow and bulster to his Wife Lyde
and one staped flitticat. I give and bequeath to my
Daughter Rachell above named two flitticats One
Blank and One silk Drinnitt. I give and bequeath

to my son James one short Ground one pair of
Hindshies, and I hereby Mminate and appoint my
son James Wiseman and Andrew Marrell my son
in Law. Executors of this my last Will and Testament
and I do hereby deny all other Wills and Testaments
Whatevver in in witness here I the said Mary Wif-
-man have set my hand and seal this Twenty eighth

seven hundred and thirty

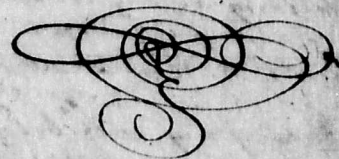

in a Negro boy named Andy second I give and be-

& Margaret all my part in 4 Negroes viz Anna & Matt
Simon and Bett Bird, under my two Horses to be
kept for the use of my Children upon the plantation
so long as they continue in a family capacity—
One of the Horses which is a Roan Colour to be the pro-
perty of my well beloved Daughter Elizabeth and one
Gray Mare to be sold and equally divided amongst
my Children, I constitute and appoint Abel Armstrong
and John Graham and my Executors of this my last
Will and Testament and Trustees for my Children
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 27th day of Apr^l in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven
hundred and thirty two signed sealed and Delivered in the
