that is allowed sufficient, and I do hereby
declare this & this alone to be my last & final
testament and do earnestly appoint Benjamin
Todd & Peter Todd Executors unto me
witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand.

December in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred
eighty five I Margaret Parks of State of North Carolina
and County of Rowan being weak in body but of per-
fect mind & memory calling to mind the mortality of
my body knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die I think proper at this time to make and
ordain this my last will & testament. And first and
principally I command my soul to God who gave it
and my body to be buried in a Christian and decent like
manner at the discretion of my Executors Nothing dark-
ening but that I shall receive the same again returned
to my soul by the mighty power of God through the
merits of my Redeemer at the Resurrection. and as
touching the good things of this life wherewithal it
hath pleased God to bless me with I do give & de-
signe my last & final bequeath in the manner & form following. First I do
allow all my just & lawfull debts to be paid. 2. I give
bequeath unto my son John one Negro boy nam-
ed Will to him his heirs & assigns forever. 3. I give
bequeath unto my son Hugh one Negro wench nam-
ed Doll to him his heirs & assigns forever. 4. I give
bequeath unto my Daughter Lian one Negro
wench named Hush & my saddle & all my wearing
apparel. 5. I give bequeath unto my two sons
John & Hugh Barkly my two Bibles. 6. I give &
bequeath unto my grand daughter Margaret

124) Daughter to my son John my bed & furniture to
her her hair, & signs forever. 7th I give & bequeath
all the remainder of my personal Estate and what
Money I have in my house unto my two Sons
John & Hugh Parks & my grand Son James Reed
to be equally divided to them each to have ~~one~~
the one third after the sale thereof to them therefore,
& signs, forever. 8th Also I appoint make & ordain
my two Sons John & Hugh Parks executors of
this my last will & testament and I do hereby
revoke & disanull all former wills by me made
ratifying & confirming this as my last revised
testament & witness whereof I hereunto set
my hand & seal the day & year first written.

it witht all prudenc. As to my worldly Estate I give
& order positively debts be paid all my worldly
debts be paid to the testmost. First I give to my dear
loving wife the privilege on my premises hold-
ing the same till my son comes to age of eighteen
years then at the end of that time I will & order that
my son John Cleaver & my daughter Susan
Cleaver having lands & tennements that lie about
it each an equal share or part of the same.
