

the same as her own sole property forever, excepting however my Dutch bible, which I give & bequeath unto my dear friend Henry Rippel as his sole property forever.

2/ I give & bequeath unto my beloved friend Christian Rippel his heirs & assigns the South part of my land, divided from the North part by the aforementioned line, beginning at George Frys North-west corner, & running a straight course West to Lazarus Hages's line containing by computation Two hundred & Forty Eight acres more or less, to have & to hold the same as his own & sole property in fee simple for ever. Provided however, that the said Christian Rippel shall pay unto his sister Sarah Rippel the just & lawfull sum of One hundred & Fifty dollars of the United States, as her share out of the aforesaid tract of land.

3/ And I do hereby make, ordain, constitute & appoint, my beloved wife Sarah & my trusty friends, Henry Rippel & John Fry, executors of this my last will & test: And do hereby disannul & make void all my former wills & legacies done by me either in writing or by word of mouth, ratifying this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 22nd Day of June 1799.

In the name of God Amen! I Martin Fisher in Rowan County in the province of N^c Carolina, being very sick & weak in body, but of perfect mind & memory, thanks be given to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body, do make & ordain this my last will & test: in manner following. I recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it; & my body to the earth to be buried in, a decent christian burial at the discretion of my beloved wife. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in the following form. First I give & bequeath to Maria Margant my dearly beloved wife, my whole estate, one tract of land, containing Three hundred acres, Negroes, waggon & team, money & all moveable effects for as she keeps a widow, if so be that she should marry. she shall have no share of the estate, then the whole estate shall be divided equally to my children. Secondly she shall maintain my father & mother as long as they live from the estate I likewise constitute, make & ordain, the sole executors, my beloved wife Maria Margant & Christian Thrueter of this last will & test. And I do hereby utterly disavow & revoke all former test, wills, legacies, or executors, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 21st Day of January A.D. 1781.
