

I do give & bequeath to my daughter Barbara all & every articles, which she has in her own possession, within my house which she claims & is known to belong to her for ever, & desire that she shall hold & enjoy for ever, all such as she has acquired by her own industry & such as I have given to her in my lifetime, without my handung or sharing of any other person.

3.) It is my will & I direct that all my just debts & funeral charges be paid out of my estate.

And I do hereby constitute & appoint my well beloved wife Christiana & my son Henry Erenhart Jr. my executors & do by these presents revoke all other written wills by me made & allow this & no other to be my last will & test: in witness whereof I the said Henry Erenhart senr. have hereunto set my hand & seal the 12th day of October. 1805.

In the name of God Amen! I Martin Newfang of Rowan County in the province of N. Carolina, (weaves, calling to mind the frailty & mortality of human life & that it is appointed for all men once to die, & being weak in body but in perfect mind, memory & understanding; I do hereby make my last will & test: in manner & form following, that is to say first & principally, I give my soul to God who giveth

my body to the earth, there to be decently buried, according to the discretion of my executors hereafter named & as for my worldly estate as it had pleased God to bless me with I give & bequeath as here followed.

1.) I desire that all my just & lawfull debts shall be paid.

2.) I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife, Anna Mary Newfang the bed & bedstead, the spinning wheel, the chest & the wheat corn & flax, that is on the place besides her part by law.

3.) Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Newfang a pewter Dish besides her share

4.) I will that my son Martin Newfang shall be well taught & brought up in the fear of God, & at the age of fifteen years he is to be bound out to trade, such as he shall choose.

5.) I will that the improvement of land shall be sold & the oats & other furniture. And to this my last will & test I make & appoint my beloved Father in law Felix Plattfelder & Michael Haug my lawfull executors to this my last will & test: in witness whereof I have before these present witnesses signed my own hand the 31st day of May 1795.

 of the County of Rowan & State of N. Carolina being
 in perfect health & of sound mind & understanding but con-
 sidering the uncertainty of this life, do make, publish &
 ordain this to be my last will & test: in manner & form
 as followed.

1. I recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it
 me, & my body to be buried, in a decent & christian manner
 at the discretion of my executors hereafter named.

2. I give & bequeath to my beloved son John Ehrenhardt
 the one half of the plantation, where I now live on, the lower
 part thereof next to Sander Klinger's, including the house
 & improvement & the clear ground thereunto belonging so
 as to have the one half of the said plantation.

3. My will is that all the other half of said plantation, after
 my death & all the personable property that I possess at
 that time shall be sold by my executors to the highest bidder
 & giving the usual credit & the money arising therefrom to be
 equally divided among all my children share & share alike,
 as is hereafter named, Mary, Elizabeth, Philip, George &
 John, Christina, Easter, Cave, Eiza Caty, Mary Margaret

4. I do hereby give my executors full power to make
 a good & sufficient title for the said one half of the plan-
 tation to be sold as if I was present myself.

5. I nominate & appoint my beloved & trusty friends -
 Jacob Brougher, & Fredrick Fisher son of Martin Fisher both
 of the County of Rowan & of the State of N. Carolina as
 my executors of this my last will & test:
