In the name of God Amen! I Mary Dowlhit. of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina, am weak in body but in perfect mind & memory thanks be given to God for his mercies & calling to mind the mortality of my body & that is appointed for all once to die, do make & ordain this my last will & test. Principally & first of all I give my soul to God who gave it me & my body to the earth, to be buried in a christian like manner at the discretion of my ~~nearest~~ friends, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching my worldly goods, I give & dispose of as follows. I will & bequeath to my son Abraham Dowlhit one feather bed & furniture & as much out of my stock or household goods as will amount to fifteen pounds besides the bed.

I will & bequeath unto my daughter Rebecca Hill one Negroe girl named Hannah. I will that my wearing apparel be equally divided between my daughters. I will & bequeath unto my granddaughter Rebecca Dowlhit, daughter to Thomas my saddle. I will & bequeath unto my son Jacob Dowlhit the remaining part of my whole estate in stock

& household, goods & also all debt due to me I do constitute & ordain my son Jacob Dowlhit executor of this my last will & test: & I do disannull & make void all other wills & bequeaths by me made or done, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 2^d day of February 1790.

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Dickey of Rowan County in N. Carolina, being afflicted in body but perfectly sound in mind & memory, knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die; It is therefore my wish & direction, that the property wherein it had God pleased to bless & disposed of in the following way & manner (viz)

1. I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Eleonor Dickey my mansion house & all household furniture thereto belonging, also all stocks of migne horses, cows, sheep & hogs, to be her & at her own disposal forever; further all my negro servants now about me, in like manner to be disposed of by her as her own property; all farming tools belonging to the plantation.
2. I give & bequeath to my daughter Martha Anderson one Negroe girl named Jude now in her possession.
3. I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane Rosbrough one Negroe girl named Pat now in her possession.
4. I give & bequeath to my son John Dickey the plantation
