And I do hereby ordain make constitute and appoint my dearly beloved wife Mary Cuninghame and my well beloved friend Robert Moore Executors of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby publish and pronounce this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and disavowing all former wills and Testaments by me made.

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved uncle Hugh Cuninghame & my dearly beloved brother Robert Cuninghame to act in my place as Executors of my Fathers Estate. In witness where of the said Joseph Cuninghame have to this my last will and Testament have set my hand and seal the day and year above written Signed sealed published and pronounced by the said Joseph Cuninghame to be his last will & Testament in the presence of us who in his presence of each other have hereunto set our names.

These two brothers David Ford and William Ellis, and my Nephew
 William Ellis each twenty shillings sterling money to be paid
 out of personal Estate above mentioned and to be paid unto
 them by my Nephew Robert Foster & John Ellis jointly
 and in the manner which may be most convenient and
 agreeable to them, and lastly I hereby nominate and appoint
 my nephew Robert Foster & John Ellis joint Executors
 of this my last will & Testament, revoking and disannulling all
 and every other will & Testament in any manner made or done
 by me & ratifying and confirming this and no other to

 said property and make sale of it and the money
 receiving of said property to be divided among the
 above legates at the decease of Martha Sinkens
 and Joel Sinkens the half of the land is Joel Sinkens
 I will the half of the tract of land where I now live
 I will to my son Isiah Sinkens by paying two hundred
