

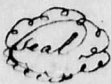
Whereon John Jones now lives to run a south line

do constitute & ordain this as my last will & Testament
and as to such worldly goods whereunto it hath pleased God to
bless me with in this life I desire that in the following
way & manner (viz) That my Body be buried in Christian
burial at the discretion of my Executors I Request
to Andrew Morison my Beloved son one guinea I give
I Bequeath to William my Beloved son the full price
of a certain Round Mare lately sold to James Wright
I Bequeath to Thomas my Beloved son one guinea & one
shilling I Bequeath to James my Beloved son a set of
fine Irons and one Bedstead I Bequeath to James
Morrison my Beloved Son in law one ^{gold} watch & have some Law
promised in money I Bequeath to Alexander McCorkle my
Beloved Son in law Round Mare & four pounds in money. I Bequeath to
John Wheeler my Beloved son in law one Shilling & ten
pence in money. I Bequeath to Mary my Beloved Daugh-
ter one Black petticoat and one Blue Kappor.
I Bequeath to Catharine my Beloved Daughter one
shagreened Kappor. I Bequeath to Sarah my Beloved Daughter
the one half of the Ready money I possess not yet
Bequeathed & all legal demands due & to be due likewise one
half of the Horned Cattle not yet Bequeathed and half of the
sheep likewise a part of my Silver Jewellery including
the Gold & silver watches and all other household furniture to be
divided at the discretion of my Executors between the said
my Margaret & her sister to be mentioned. I Bequeath to Margaret
my Beloved Daughter the other half of the Horned Cattle & sheep
above mentioned likewise the other half of my Read money as afore-
said with a part of all my household furniture my Black gown
& my Kitt to be given at the discretion of my Executors I Bequeath
to my son Andrew daughter Mary my saddle and a canton apron I
Bequeath to my son James daughter Elizabeth one Red Kappor
And do by this present constitute appoint & ordain my sons the said
Andrew & James my Executors of this my last will & Testament & do hereby revoke & disannul all
other wills & Testaments I Bequeath & confirm this only to be my last will
& Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this
fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
& Eighty four.
