I do give and bequeath and do my Beloved Son Jonathan in care of my Beloved Wife so long as he or she shall live likewise I do give ~~to~~ ^{unto} my dearly Beloved wife the sum of five pounds per year for his maintenance and I do allow my ~~my~~ Negroes to be hired out in my family and out of there hire the five pounds paid to my Beloved wife yearly likewise I do give ^{and bequeath} to my Beloved wife her side saddle and little wheel all the remainder of my Goods and Chattles not here willed or bequeathed I do allow to be set up at public Sale and the money to be Equally distributed with the remainder part of the hire of the Negroes Amongst seven of my Children to wit, George Reed Felps Reed Thomas Reed William Reed Amos Reed Edith Reed Elizabeth Reed I do appoint and ordain Robert M'He Eg' and Richard Wilson my Executors of this my last will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and annul all and every other Wills or Testaments Wills legacies and Bequeaths and Executors anywise Before named willed and Bequeathed Relieving and Confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year above Written signed sealed published pronounced and declared by the said George Reed

John Blanket pickers Children. I give and for my own
Clothes and sheets and some cotten yarn I leave to be

wise my Iron pot my pewter and all the money
that is now owing to me to be Equally divided betwixt
all my Children and as for my waxe reeds and red-

for any other small articles about the house not mentioned
