 and Chattles not here willed or bequeathed I do allow to
 be set up at public Sale and the money to be Equally
 distributed with the remainder part of the hire of the
 Negroes Amongst seven of my Children to wit, George Reed Felp
 Reed Thomas Reed William Reed Amos Reed ~~Edith~~ Reed ~~Edith~~ Reed
 I do appoint and ordain Robert Mth Esq^r and Richard Wilson
 my Executors of this my last will and Testament and I do
 hereby utterly disavow revoke and annul all and every
 other Wills or Testaments Wills legacies and Bequeaths
 and Executors anywise Before named willed and Be-
 queathed Relieving and Confirming this and no other to
 be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand and seal the day
 and year above Written signed sealed published, pro-
 nounced and declared by the said George Reed

to my Granddaughter Mary Blandteller my little feather
bed and my Black Cloak I give and bequeath
to my Grandson John Blanketpucker one bay horse
Colt and likewise my part of George Blanketpucker
Estate in Virginia I leave to be Equally divided among
John Blanketpucker Children. I give and for my wearing
clothes and sheets and some cotton yarn I leave to be
Equally divided ^{between} ~~among~~ my own daughters and like-
wise my Iron pot my pewter and all the money
that is now owing to me to be Equally divided between
all my Children and as for my ware reds and red-

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ing saddles to be Equally divided between them all and
for any other small articles about the house not mentioned
here I direct to be left to my son Michael Myers which
I do make and constitute with Joseph Bowen to be my
Executors of this my last will and testament dated the
fourteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and
eighty four signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
