

I shall be thought proper by my wife & my Executors  
to be provided by them what I may necessary there to do  
& her heirs forever. Further it is my will that the whole of  
my Estate except those things before mentioned to be sold at  
public auction, that the land owned by my son James &  
my Negro fellow be sold at my wife's direction in the same  
manner that each sum be divided by my Executors  
into twelve equal parts. To be distributed among  
me in the following manner. First they give to  
my Son William two twelfths of the whole to my  
son James two twelfths of the whole to my daughter  
Margaret two twelfths of the whole that the rest of my  
children Sons & daughters have each one twelfth  
of the whole to them & these heirs forever provided  
that my two Faddes body Cloathes gun & book  
be disposed of at discretion by my Executors, that the  
piece of Gold above mentioned of six pound value  
be given to my daughter Margaret and her heirs  
forever. That four steers be reserved of my stock  
for the support of my wife and daughter during  
the following ages Viz (one of four years and of  
three years, one & two years one of one year old  
also all my stock of those together with the  
whole Calf now in my Ground for the proportion  
above mentioned. It is also my will that my two  
Sons Andrew & Thomas Morrison be constituted  
Executors of this my last will & Testament  
And I do hereby utterly revoke & disannull  
any other Testament with & legacy by me  
before this time made written or bequeathed either  
partly or the other to be my last will & testament  
made in witness whereof

I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day of (99)

In the name of God Amen I Matthew  
Adams of the State of North Carolina and County of New-  
bern aforesaid being very sick and low in Body yet to  
perfect mind and Memory blessed be God, and calling  
to mind the mortality of my Body and that it is appoint-  
ed for all once to die do therefore make and ordain this  
my last Will and Testament in manner and form as  
follows Viz — Item 1st I resign up my soul into  
the hands of Almighty God who gives it and my body  
I commit to the Earth to be buried in a decent  
manner at the discretion of my Executors, nothing  
doubting but I shall receive it again through the  
mighty power of Christ, and as touching such world-  
ly things substance as it hath pleased God to  
bless me with, I dispose in manner and form  
as follows —

100) Item I will and Ordain that all my law-  
full debts be buried and pay'd out of my personal  
estate. Item 3<sup>d</sup> I also will and Ordain that my son  
George and Daughters viz Mary, Eliza and Frances  
shall have sufficient Schooling to be paid out of my  
estate. Item 4<sup>th</sup> I leave and Bequeath unto my belo-  
ved son Walter the Negro Wench Anna with her increase  
except her first born, which I ordain to be given unto  
Eliza when the child is two years old but if Eliza dies  
under age said Negro child to be given unto my  
Daughter Frances. Item 5<sup>th</sup> I leave and Bequeath  
unto my beloved Son George the Negro boy Anna to  
him at the years of Maturity but if George  
should die in Minority then the Negro Anna to be  
given unto my Daughter Rachel. Item 6<sup>th</sup> I  
leave and Bequeath unto my beloved Daughter  
Elizabeth my black Cow. Item 7<sup>th</sup> I leave and  
Bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Diana my  
white Calf. Item 8<sup>th</sup> I also leave and Bequeath  
unto my beloved Daughter ~~Nancy~~<sup>the Negro</sup>  
~~Rachel~~ my red and white Calf. Item 9<sup>th</sup> I  
leave and Bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Nancy  
my red Calf. Item 10<sup>th</sup> I also leave and Bequeath  
unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth my Mansion

House and Lands during her life time to 101  
herself with all their Accoutrements profits and  
advantages for her maintenance and bringing  
up of my four youngest Children as also my  
Negro Man Harry and Negro Wench Betty to have  
and to hold during her life and at her death the  
land to be equally divided between my beloved sons  
Eliza and Matthew and the above said Negroes  
to be equally divided amongst my Daughters  
that I have left no Slaves unto. Provided further  
that if my beloved Wife Elizabeth should die shortly  
I ordain that the above said Plantation and Slaves  
with all their profits and advantages (viz their  
Tents and Huts) should be expended in bringing  
up my four youngest Children until the young-  
est is twelve years old, and then to be divided as  
above written, but if Negro Betty have issue during  
my Wifes life time the said Issue I will and ordain  
to be equally divided amongst my Daughters that I  
have left no particular slaves unto, and as touching  
all the rest of my Goods and Chattels, I leave and  
Bequeath unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth to have  
and to hold for ever except Negro Abraham  
Item 11<sup>th</sup> I also leave and Bequeath unto my

102 Beloved Daughter Diana Negro Abraham  
At Wm 12th I also will and ordain that my beloved  
sons Willie and Luke shall be the sole Executors  
of this my last Will and Testament, and I do here-  
by revoke and disannull all former Wills and  
Testaments whatsoever, Given under my hand  
and seal this 6th day of June Anno Domini  
One thousand seven hundred and eighty One  
Signed sealed pronounced and <sup>Sealed</sup> in the  
presence of me

Whereas I David Davis being in a low state of  
Health and knowing not the day of my death yet  
being of perfect mind and Memory desire it  
necessary to constitute this my last Will and  
Testament, and first of all I do assign my

spirit to god that gave it, hoping that it <sup>103</sup>  
may and through faith do believe that it will  
be raised at the general Resurrection and admitted  
with this Body and received into glory and  
next of all I do resign my Body to the earth  
with all the charges of a decent Burial AND  
furthermore in regard of my worldly Goods, Chattels  
Pands and Instruments by these presents do will  
and confirm as follows. A certain tract and  
parcel of land lying and being in the County and  
State aforesaid on the Yadkin River below the mouth  
of flat swamp on the north side of said river, contain-  
ing three hundred acres more or less agreeable to  
the surveying thereof. To my wife Hannah Davis during  
her widowhood, remains and remanded to my daughter  
Elizabeth Davis with all the rights better and ap-  
pertaining therunto belonging, to have and to  
hold forever I slight of down excepted. The above  
land to be dealt with agreeable to the last will  
and Testament of John Davis deceased between  
Bryja Davis & David Davis, Furthermore  
my part of the homestead plantation agreeable  
to the last will of John Davis my Father
