in the State of Connecticut now of Rowan in the District
of Salisbury & State of N^o. Carolina is as follows that all
my just debts should be paid & a plain but decent funeral
ordered by my executors.

Item I give & bequeath to my brother Samuel Bedden the
one half of what may remain due from my fathers estate
which I should suppose was considerable, also a debt about
fourty pounds cash which I lent him money, which he,
received of Mr. Nath^r Shaw on preciouz that no debt as brought
against my estate from that part of the world.

I give & bequeath to my brother Will^m Coit the one half of
what may remain due from my fathers estate which I shall
suppose was considerable

Item I give & bequeath to all the children of my brother Bedden
which shall remain single at my decease & to all the children
of my brother Coit which shall remain single at my decease
to be divided share & share alike all my right & title to my
mothers estate of what ever kind soever both real & personal.

Item I give & bequeath to my sister Sarah Mumford Piney
a Negro girl Elce & all my wearing apparel furniture
which may remain undisposed of at my decease.

Item I give & bequeath to my brother in law Robinson Mumford
my Negro girl Cate, also all accounts, debts, due of what
every kind or nature soever to be, give up without coming to any
settlement & it is expected that their will no charge brought
against my estate by my brother Mumford either account,

or charges as executors.

Item I give & bequeath to my Nephew Robinson Mumford my
Negroe woman Dinah & half dozen large silver spoons if
it should so happen that Dinah should continue to have children
after she comes in to Bobs hands I desire that the first
son she has may be given to James Alexander, the next child
either boy or girl to Eliza Murley, the rest to Sophia the
next to Sarah if there should be so many.

Item I give & bequeath to my Nephew James Mumford my
Negroe boy Billy.

Item I give & bequeath to my Niece Elizabeth Pearson my
green silk bed quilt.

Item I give & bequeath to my Nephew George Mumford
my Negro girl Flora.

Item I give & bequeath to my Niece Hitty Coit Mumford my
Negroe woman Phillis also my silver Can my large silver
spooner & pair sugar Tongues I also request that her father
would have a dozen of tea spoons made with my mark in
sign of her 17 I brought when I came to the house.

Item I give & bequeath to my Nephew Gile P^rns Mum-
ford my Negro girl Judith.

Item I give & bequeath to my Nephew Caleb Christopher
Mumford my Negro child by Phillis.

I appoint my brother in law Robinson Mumford sole
executor of this my last will & test^d. made this 25th day
of November 1762. signed with my own hand sealed with
my own seal & declare it as my last will & test^d.
