Do on this sixteenth day of December in the Year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty four make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first of all I command my soul unto the hands of Almighty God who gave all things and as for my Body I com mend to the earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors in a Christian like manner hoping at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same by the merits of God and as touching my worldly Estate as the Lord hath pleased to bless me with give divers and dispor of the same in the manner and form following that is to say in the first place I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Elizabeth Clifford all my personal Estate during her Natural life, Secondly I give to her my wife all that parcel of Land hereafter

mentioned for my Son Michael and Jacob Clifford during their wedlock or natural life. I give and bequeath to my beloved son John Clifford for the sum of 20/- piece, also give to beloved Daughter Eleanor Westmor Twenty Shillings piece also give to my Daughter Sarah Haines 20/- piece, also give to my Daughter Catharine Pippins 20/- piece, also give to my Daughter Elizabeth Woods 20/- piece, also give to my Daughter Eve Eaton 20/- piece Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Son Jacob Clifford that piece and parcel of land beginning at the end of Richard Haines second line of that land the said Haines had of me, then running S. 200 paces then east to John Cliffford's line including all my land that lays North of them Two Courses to him or his heirs & assigns forever, also give and bequeath to my beloved Son Michael Clifford all that piece and parcel of land Beginning at the end of the Two hundred paces first mentioned to Jacob Clifford running east to Ebenezer Eaton line including all my land laying on the south side of said line agreeable to my Bond given to him for the said piece of land, to him his heirs and assigns forever.
