Grace and Goodness of God, though weak in Body yet of a
sound & perfect Understanding and Memory do constitute this my
last Will & Testament and now it may be recorded by all as such.
First I most humbly bequeath my Soul to God my Maker, before whom
I most Acquiesced of it, through the all sufficient Merit &
Mediation of my most compassionate Redemer Jesus Christ, who
gave himself to be an Atonement for my sins, and is able to save to
the uttermost, all that cometh to him by him, saving his own life to make
intercession for them, and who I trust will not reject me, returning
at dinner when I come to him for Mercy; in this hope and
trust I render up my soul with comfort humbly beseeching the
Blessed Everlasting Trinity, one God, most holy, most judicious &
wise to prepare me for the time of my dissolution, and to take
me with into that peaceful Rest, and incomparable Joy which
is prepared for all that love & fear his holy Name. When I yield
my Body to the Earth from whence it was taken in
full expectation of its Resurrection from thence at the coming As

111) manage it with all requisite Prudence. As to my worldly Estate I will
and positively order, that all my Debts to be paid first I give & bequeath
unto my dear & loving Wife Mary Myers a Plantation in Hertford
County (which I had by purchase from George King George the Second) to her her
Life Time together with Furniture and other Conveniences requisite for her
on P. place. Likewise a Plantation called the New Branch neare her Life Time
together with all Conveniences belonging thereto. Likewise half the planta-
tion I now live on in Person County with the half of the Profit of the same
that is thereon together with all my movable Estate to carry the bringing
up of my children and the movable Estate shall be at her own disposal to
what she will therewith. Item I give & bequeath to Henry Dohad Jr. and
two hundred Acres of Land lying & being in Hertford County to
his Heirs & Assigns forever, but so as the said Henry Dohad shall not
or dispose of the Land without the consent of his wife Elizabeth Dohad
formerly Eliz. Myers. Item I give & bequeath my daughter Barbara Myers
one two hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land it being the last End of an
125 acre tract of Land lying and being on the South Side of P. D. in Her-
tford County to her & her Heirs & Assigns forever after her death
Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Myers two hundred acres
Land the last End of the 125 acre tract of Land in Hertford County ap-
to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. Item I give & bequeath my son Michael
Myers two hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land part of the Plantation
where I now live together with all the Appurtenances thereto belonging
after the Death of his Mother, and till her Death to have but half the
Profit of such Plantation to him his Heirs & Assigns forever.
Item I give & bequeath untoannah Myers one hundred & Seven
the remaining part of the Plantation where I now live on the
corner on a branch called Millers Branch to her her Heirs & Assigns
forever. Item I give & bequeath unto John Blacksticker and his
Myers a tract of Land called the New Branch neare after the Death of his
Mother to be equally to be divided between them their Heirs &

Estate as followeth to wit. First of all I give to my Dearly
beloved Wife. Ann McQuiston & and my Son Walter McQuiston
all my Estate Debts and reasonable equity to be divided between
them except what I shall hereafter bequeath to the Rest of
my children with my Plantation and all the perticulars there-
unto belonging during her life time or widowhood then to my
Son Walter McQuiston if marie again I allow her but twenty
Pounds and her Riding & Bed of Cloas with a Chair & stool
and her Part of the Money to her to dispose as she shall think fit
and my warning release to divide them as she thinks fit. Secondly
I give my Son James McQuiston my only son and

is, I bequeath his Son Robert McQuiston Thirdly I give to John
Fridell or my Daughter Margery one Guine to be given to my gran-
daughter Ann. Fourthly I give to my Son John McQuiston fifty Pounds to be
paid out of the first Guine due of my Plantation of Roward. Fifthly I give
to my Daughter Jean McQuiston married to James Thirdly twenty Pounds
to be paid out of the two first Guines now by William Godfray.
Sixtly I give to my Daughter Catharina McQuiston & Mary McQuiston each
of them thirty Pounds a piece out of the two last Guines of my Plantation
& black man & child of said Maine Fridell and a set to be given and
whoever gets the black man is to get three Pounds and their Rides
& Cloas to their Mothers Pleasure Lastly I make my Will and my
Son Walter Executors of this my last Will & Testament and That this
testimony given signed sealed published & declared in the presence
of us.

lives to my Son Samuel McQuistock it being situated on & west of George
Davidson senior land consisting of three hundred & eighty Six acres
of Land to him & his Heirs forever. I give to my Son William Mc-
Quistock three hundred Acres of land situated on & west of the Plantation
on which I live & the rest of his brother old McQuistock
