 pointed for all Men once to die Do make & ordain this my last
 Will and Testament That is to say principally and
 I give and recommend my Soul into the Hand of Almighty God that
 guard it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a
 Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting
 but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again
 by the mighty Power of God & as touching my worldly Estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give
 and devise & dispose of the same in the following manner

First I will & bequeath unto my loving Daughter Margaret Davis the sum of
 proclamation money. I likewise give and bequeath unto my Daughter Cath-
 erine Annan the sum of three pounds proclamation money. And give likewise unto my

 mation money. I likewise give & bequeath unto my beloved Son Michael Coon
 the sum of three pounds proclamation money. I likewise give unto my son
 Anthony Coon the sum of three pounds proclamation money. I likewise give and
 bequeath unto my son Valentine Coon the sum of three pounds & money. I
 likewise give & bequeath unto my Daughter Annan the sum of three pounds
 proclamation money. And it is my Will that my above mentioned
 seven shall not receive the above mentioned sums of money until the
 expiration of the Term of nine years from the date hereof. I like-
 wise give and bequeath unto my loving Daughter Margaret which my Wife
