Further I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth
her Bed and furniture and my Pleasant Horse and his Tack
and two Sheep over and above her ^{usual} proper Dowing also the
two Horses and the other Utencials belonging to the said house,
one Cow and Calf. — further it is my Will that my two Sons
Joseph Todd and Thomas Todd shall have my Land equally
divided between them by a line to begin at the Riverbank as
near the middle Distance as can be taken and running to the
back or outside Line so as to divide it as equally as possible
it may be done in two parts, my Son Joseph to have the lower
part down the River, and my Son Thomas the upper part
including the dwelling house and all other Improvements on
the same. Also my Will is that all my personal Estate be equally
divided among my children excepting such articles as shall
be hereafter named. Unto my Son Thomas I give and bequeath
one solid Mass bridle & saddle and the plow and Cart & tools
there belonging, also what iron & lead there that is not worked
up and one thousand feet of plank at the saw mill and the
Nails and Tacks that is provided for building a House on
his part of the Land also a Rifle Gun, also to my Daughter
Elizabeth one half Pounds in Gold, and also to my Daughter
Sarah Lewis one half Pounds in Gold, also to my Daughter
Sarah Todd one bed and furniture & little Wheel and a bow and
bale and one half Pounds in Gold, also to my Daughter Gertrude
one bed and furniture & little Wheel and one bow and
one half Pounds in Gold, as in Gold & the Coton of the year

to be to the uses of the two young daughters of said
Sarah & Gertrude, all the rest and residue of my personal Estate
is to be equally divided among my Children
only the grain that grows Wheat & Barley for the year
and the like are to be and remain for the use of the Girls
and to God the Stock as to my wearing apparel I will
my Son Joseph is to have my wortled coat & jacket all the
Remains of my Apparel I will to the use of my Son Thomas
Todd Likewise appoint my Sons living Sons of
D Thomas Todd sole Exec of this my last Will & Testament
executing all other Wills Legacies & Bequests by me made
you make ratifying and confirming this to be my last
Will and Testament. In witness whereof I do set my
Hand & Seal this thirty first day of October in the Year
of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred & twenty
seven. Signed sealed & pronounced

the world under his holy Name Amen. I give my Body to the
Earth whence it was taken in full assurance of its
return from thence at the last day. As for my buried
it may be decent without pomp or superflalty at the de-
cration of my Wife & Executor hereafter named who I doubt
not will manage it with all requisite prudenc. And as to
my worldly Estate I will and positively beare that all my
debt to be paid, and that so much of my personal estate be
left as shall be sufficient to satisfy all my creditors. Item I
do and bequeath the plantation now in my own occupation

and bequeath to them and their heirs forever to be equally divided

my Stock such as she may chuse and the rest
of sheep to be chosen at her pleasure (and the same
her husband's possession, to her & her heirs & assigns forever
the remainder of my personal Estate and moveable Effects
I will and order them to be sold and whatsoever the said
able goods & effects may amount to I will and order it to
equally divided amongst my four Daughters except my
Deed which I give to my three Sons to their own prepara-
tion and behoof. Lastly I do make and constitute my loving
brother Isaac sole Executor of this my last Will &
Testament and as Trustee for my Wife and Children
In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the
fifth day of January one thousand seven hundred &
forty eight & in the second year of American Declara-
tion.
