I ~~Shew~~ constitute and ordain this my loving Wife Elizabeth and my Dutiful son Jones Latimer to be this my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament —

In the name of God Amen. I Mrs. Mabel of Newen County, being of sound and perfect mind and memory (blessed be God) do this 7th day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and eighty second: Make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say, first I give and bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my Body to the dust to be buried after a decent Christian manner, not doubting at the Resurrection to receive the same by the Almighty power of God, And as touching my worldly Goods, that it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give and dispose of in manner following (W^{ill} first I order that all my just debts be paid

secondly, that all my lands and Goods and Chattels be sold at Public Vendue, and that one third of the value arising from said sale, after all debts are discharged, I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth the Remainder arising from said sale: I will and devise, to be equally divided between my Children herein named, William Bp^r Ester Thomas and Stephenson. Then to my son John, I give and bequeath one suit of black Cloath, and all my books (except a large bible) to be disposed of at his discretion. Then to my son Samuel I give and bequeath one suit of light Coloured Cloath, and a large Bible. To my son John, I also give all my reeds and Guns, the Crops now in the ground. I desire to be sold with my other Goods. Then to my Daughter Ester I give and bequeath all my right and title farred Cow and her calf, the Cow formerly given the said Ester by Mary Steinson — I nominate authorize and constitute my trusty and well beloved friends, Robert King and Hugh Brown

Call of Rowan County in the Province of North
Carolina planter being of sound and disposing
mind and Memory do make and Ordain this my
last Will and Testament in manner and form
following, that is to say I will that all my debts

and bequeath unto my son John Call one Cow
and Calf and unto Henry Call And Adam &
Daniel and each of my daughters, Margaret

Call, Christiana, Dorothy and Eve, fifteen ⁽¹⁵⁾ shil-
lings lawful money of the said Province to be
raised and layed out of my Estate, next I give
and bequeath unto my loving Wife Catherine Call
all the rest of the real and personal Estate belonging
unto me in Goods lands Chattels during her life
time and after her decease to descend and belong
the land unto Daniel Call, and he not choosing
to take the land it shall be valued by the rest of his
Brothers and he shall receive and equal share, with
them Likewise I leave unto my loving Daughter Ann
Mary Call fifteen shillings, and the rest of my real
and personal Estate that I have to my loving
Wife Catherine Call. I will and bequeath that after her
decease it may equally be divided all my Children
And lastly I do ordain constitute and appoint
my dearly beloved Wife Catherine Call sole executrix
of this my last will and Testament utterly revoking
and disavowing all former wills and Testaments by
me made. Witness this to be my last and
