

(15) Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> 1782 I Will constitute and ordain this my loving Wife Elizabeth and my dutiful son Jones Lutman to be the my sole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament —

In the name of God Amen. I Moses Marshall of Worcester County, being sound and perfect mind and memory (I thank be God) do this 7<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and seventy seven. Make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say, first I give and bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my Body to the dust to be buried after a decent Christian manner, not doubting at the Resurrection to receive the same by the Almighty power of God. And as touching my worldly Goods, that it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give and dispose of in manner following (Very first Order) that all my just Debts be paid

Secondly, that all my lands and Goods and Chattels be sold at public Vendue, and that one third of the value arising from said sale, after all debts are discharged, I give and bequeath unto my well beloved wife Elizabeth the remainder arising from said sale. I will and desire to be equally divided between my Children four named, William Ross, Esther Thomas and Stephen. Item to my Son John, I give and bequeath one suit of black Cloth, and all my books (except a large Bible) to be disposed of at his discretion. Item to my Son Samuel I give and bequeath one suit of light Coloured Cloaths and a large Bible. To my Son John, I also give all my rods and Furs, the Cope now in the ground. I desire to be sold with my other Goods. Item to my Daughter Esther I give and bequeath all my right and title of red Cow and her Calf, the Cow formerly given the said Esther by Mary Stinson — nominate authority and constitute my trusty and well beloved friends Robert King and Hugh Brown

and personal Estate that I leave to my loving  
Wife Catharine Call. I will and bequeath that after her  
decease it may equally be divided all my children  
And lastly I do ordain constitute and appoint  
my dearly beloved Wife Catharine Call sole executrix  
of this my last will and Testament attorney looking  
and disannulling all former wills and Testaments by  
me made allowing this to be my last and
