3. I will that my beloved wife Mary shall have my land & plantation where I now live in her care during her widowhood & if she shall marry or after her death I will that the land shall be sold & the money arising therefrom to be equally divided amongst all my children with a Allowance to be made by them that has had any legacies herefore to the others that has nothing to make a equal division amongst the whole of my children.
4. I will that all my stock of horses & cattle household goods & implements belonging to the plantation be sold at public sale & the money to be equally divided amongst

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my children as before mentioned & what debt is due to me is to be equally divided as aforesaid. My wife is to have a child's part with the children out of the stock & household goods besides what I wished to her.

I will that John Hendricks have that hundred acres of land that I bought of George Mark & also what land he agreed with me for out of my tract & eighty pounds which he is to pay for it is to be divided between my wife & children equally. I do hereby constitute and appoint my well beloved friends Jacob Croni & Jacob Booe my executors of this my last will & test. & I do hereby disannul & make void all other wills & bequests by me made or done ratifying & allowing this & no other to be my last will & testament. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Dean Templeton eight shillings. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my son John White eight shillings, likewise I give & bequeath unto my son James White eight shillings. Likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth Red eight shillings. Likewise, I give & bequeath unto my Mary McCow eight shillings - likewise I give & bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Wilson eight shilling. The remainder part of my estate moveable estate I allow for the rearing & maintaining of the widow & my children & to portion them off when they may need it at the discretion of their mother & the other executors.
