 the surviving or surviving or his or their heirs; Lastly the Legacies
 as is already mentioned and the Duties is to be paid out of my
 Rents in Pennsylvania as the become due; and what Cash or debts
 due by Bonds or otherwise remains due after the funeral Charges
 just Debts Legacies Duties or any other just Debt whatsoever
 against the Estate without any Reserve as is already mentioned
