In the name of God Amen? the 14th day of April 1803 I, Nancy Martin of the County of Rowan & State of N. Carolina being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God. Therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all once to die, I do make & ordain this my last will & testament. That is to say:-

Principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the band of almighty God that gave it & my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent & Christian burial at the discretion of my executors. Nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the almighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate, wherein it has pleased God to bless me in this life. I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

First I give & bequeath to my well beloved daughter Jane Willson my black gown & a short gown & cotton gown & all my caps & my black silk handkerchief I bequeath to my well beloved son Elijah the course kettle also I bequeath to my grand daughter Rachael Graham my blue gown & buff petticoat & my fine shackle a pewter dish & three pewter plates & Tresser furniture. & the remainder of the pewter, to Elijah & my horse & one Cowhice & one to my son Joseph & my Cow & loon, to Elijah & he to pay the right of the children & equal share & one single blanket & one to Rachael & one flat Iron & one flat Iron to Joseph & my wheel to Rachael & the wheel for the use of the house & my oven to Elijah & my sheet & cow bell, my feather bed & pounters pane & bolster to Hanny Martin & the pot racks to Elijah & one Churn And I do likewise constitute make & ordain my well beloved son John Martin my sole executor of this my last will & testament & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all & every other former testaments, wills, legacies, bequeaths & executors by me in any way

First I will that all my debts & funeral charges

Daniel Mock shall give his honoured Mother fifty
bushels of wheat & fifty bushels of corn & two hundred
weight of pork yearly & also give my beloved wife
Phebe Mock one brown Mare, bridle & side saddle & one
negro boy slave by the name of Liser & one Negro girl by
the name of Mago two feather beds & furniture one
spinning wheel, one Iron pot one Dutch oven, one washing
pot & one hundred pounds hard money to be recovered of
the vendue money & also two Cows & calves & that my
son shall feed the stock that I have willed to his ho
noured mother, free gratis enduring her life time or widoa
hood, which Negro boy Liser that I have left to my
beloved wife enduring her lifetime my will & desire is
that my son Daniel Mock shall have him as his own
property at her death & all the above mentioned article
that is mentioned in Daniel Mocks name to him &
his heirs & assigns for ever.

And what is given as above mentioned to my beloved
wife all but the negro boy Liser which is only for
her life time or widowhood. I give & bequeath to my
beloved son Daniel Mock to him & his heirs forever.
