subscribed, are the following Words viz:

I also do hereby give & bequeath & empower & by these pre-
sents to give & bequeath & empower all my Right Title and
Interest that I have in the Lands & Lots in the Township
of Salisbury where they are not yet sold nor promised as here-
tofore as if I were then myself together with all the bene-
fits & profits thereof arising also ten pounds a piece to be
levied out of my Estate towards their defraying their
Charge in the Administration And my Will further is-

In the Name of God Amen the thirteenth Day of Sep-
tember in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred
& seventy nine I Nathaniel Curry of North Carolina
& Province of South Carolina, being very sick & weak in
body but of perfect mind & memory Thanks be given unto
God therefore calling unto mind the mortality of my Body

and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make
Ordain this my last Will & Testament; that is to say principally and first
of all, I give & recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave
it, & for my Body I recommend it to the Earth, to be buried in a Christian
like & decent Manner, at the Direction of my Executors; not doubting
but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of God, and as touching such worldly Estate wherewith
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I give, devise & dispose of the
same in the following Manner & Form. I hereby I give & bequeath to
my well beloved wife Eliza Curry, whom I likewise constitute make and
ordain my only & sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament, all & the
singular of all my Goods and Chattels by her fully to be possessed and
enjoyed together with all my household Goods & Furniture & movables to
be disposed of as she shall think proper, yet within my Family &c.
I likewise I bequeath to my eldest Daughter, the said Eliza Curry, the sum of
fifty Shillings to be paid of my Estate. I likewise I bequeath to my two Grandchildren (that is to say)
Samuel Curry & Joseph Curry one Part of Land containing two hundred
and fifty Acres lying in a Branch of Broad River called Broad it to be
equally divided between the two Children bought of Hercules Moore
lying at the mouth of Birdins Creek to be possessed by said Samuel and
Joseph Curry when they arrive to the Years of Maturity. I likewise I bequeath
to Dorothy Miller one Mare come of the Mare that was bought of Bluff
Shoemaker by her to be possessed and the Mare to be free from any servitude or
persons whatsoever. And I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke & disannul
all & every other Testaments, Wills, & Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me
in any ways before this Time named, willed & bequeathed, ratifying &
confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament, In witness
