Item I give to my dear & loving wife for term of life the house & plantation where I now live also two feather beds & furniture two cows & earlings, two pewter dishes, two basons & a half dozen plates & a horse bridle & saddle & after her decease the land to be equally divided between my two sons Jeremiah & Jonathan, The moveable property I bequeath to my loving wife & after her death to be equally divided between my son & two daughters (viz) Jordan & Susanna & Elizabeth I give to my son Zachariah a chare colt two years old one cow & earling, three pewter plates & one basin to be delivered on demand; to my daughter Susanna one feather bed & furniture, to be delivered at my death or at my pleasure before. Item I give unto my son John William Burnett & Simeon one shilling to each of them. I give to my daughter Nancy Meritt one shilling I give to my daughter Martha Clements one Cow & lamb I give to my daughter Prudence one shilling I give to my daughter Sarah Canaday one huffer, I give to my daughter Patience Eggers one Cow. I also give & desire all my stock of hogs to the use of my loving wife to rise the small children & constitute & appoint my dear loving wife Mrs Elizabeth with my trusty son Zachariah executors of this my last will & test in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 26th day of Jan: 1793.

In the name of God Amen. I Nicolas Cresson of the County of Howard & State of N.B. Carolina being by the abundant Mercy of God so weak of body, but of sound & perfect understanding & memory, do constitute this my last will & test: & desire it to be received by all as such: Imposing I most humbly bequeath my soul to God, & my body to the earth from whence it was taken, in full assurance of its resurrection from thence at the last day; as for my burial I desire it may be decent without pomp or state at the direction of my dear wife & my executors hereafter named, who I doubt not, will manage it with all requisit prudence & to my worldly estate, I will & positively order that all my debts be paid. Item I give to my dear & loving wife for term of life this house wherein I now dwell, with a bed beded & furniture likewise all the pewter that is in the house a black walnut chest & drawers & the third of my land that lays about the house, a cow & heifer. And I will that all my land & all that I possess be equally divided between my children, Samuel, Catharine, Mary, Eve, Sophia, Margaret & Philispine. And I do constitute my son Samuel & Henry Bruner executors of this my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the 20th day of August A.D. 1799.
