

In the name of God Amen! the 13th day of October 1789.
 I, Conrad Davis of Rowan County & State of N.C.
 Carolina, being in good health of body & sound mind & memory
 thanks be to the Lord for the same. But calling to mind the
 mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all
 men to die do make & ordain this my last will & test which is
 to say principally I give my soul to God who gave it & my
 body to the earth, to be buried in a decent & christian burial at
 the discretion of my executors hereafter named, & as for such ready
 estate as it had pleased God to bestow me in this life I give devise
 & dispose of the same in the manner & form following.

Item: I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Davis the
 plantation whereon I now live together with one feather bed
 & furniture also one mare & two cows, & four sheep one side
 saddle, one pot, one peacock bacon three plates, three knives &
 forks.

Item I give to my son Henry Davis one shilling sterling.

Item I give to my daughter Mary Baileay one shilling sterling.

Item I give & bequeath to my son Andrew Davis one hundred
 & fifty acres of land including the plantation whereon Joseph
 New now lives, together with one gray mare called Doty, &
 set of smiths tools, & three cows, five sheep one feather bed &
 furniture & one half of a crop cut saw & half a waggon
 & gear & half one loom & half one wind mill & one saddle
 & bridle.

Item I give & bequeath to Morris Davis one hundred &
 fifty acres of land including the plantation whereon I
 now live, together with one black horse, & one year old colt

three cows & five steers, also one feather bed & furniture one
 half of a waggon & gears, half a crop cut saw & half a
 wind mill & my will & pleasure is that all my other estate
 real & personal be equally divided between my two sons Andrew
 & Morris & I do hereby ratify & confirm this & this alone
 to be my last will & test: unto which I appoint Thomas
 Todd, Andrew Davis & Morris Davis executors. In witness
 whereof I have set here my hand & seal the day & year above
 written

In the name of God Amen! I, Patty Daniel
 of the County of Rowan & State of N.C. Carolina being
 weakly in body, but being in my senses & of a good mem-
 ory do make this my last will & test.

1. I recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to the
 earth to be buried in a christian decent manner at the discretion
 of my executors hereafter named.

2. I will & bequeath my negro girl named Cherry to my
 mother Elizabeth during the term of her natural life &
 after my mothers decease the said negro girl to be sold
 at public sale & the money arising of the said negro girl
 to be equally divided among my brothers & sisters.

3. I do hereby nominate & appoint my beloved brothers
 Ephraim & Shepard Daniel executors of this my
 last will & test: denying all other wills & test: by
 me made heretofore In witness whereof I have hereunto

set my hand & seal. This 18th day of February AD 1800.
 Signed, sealed, & delivered

In the name of God Amn! I Balsor Duttraw
 of Rowan County & State of N^o: Carolina. This day being
 weak of body - but of sound mind & memory & desirous that
 he to God for his mercies & calling to mind the mortality of
 the body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die &
 after death to judgment. I resign myself up to God —
 And as touching my worldly goods, as it had pleased God to
 bless me with in this life I do on this 22nd day of February
 AD: 1801 give devise & dispose of in manner & form following
 that is to say. First I give & bequeath to my dearly beloved
 son Jacob Duttraw one hundred & ninety acres of land to
 include my dwelling plantation, whereon I now live to
 him his heirs & assigns forever & 2d I give & bequeath
 to my son David Duttraw one hundred & seventy nine
 acres of land, composed of the following pieces of land &
 to be laid off in the following manner viz 1 fifty acres
 of this my original tract & forty acres taken up by
 me as surveyors land & thirty nine acres I bought of
 John Adams & fifty acre I bought of Richard Leach
 all of which land to be laid off in the following manner
 beginning on Lathans line & runs a straight line to
 Marked Poplar - I made for this devise & then runs a

west course to the surveyors boundary aces, & in case it does not
 hold out measure to make the above quantity of one hundred
 & seventy nine acres the west line from the Poplar must
 not extend so far as the surveyor, so of the quantity to be in-
 cluded, all this I give to him, the said David Duttraw his
 heirs & assigns forever. 3d My will & desire is that all my
 personal estate except plantation tools shall be appraised
 by three men chosen by my executors & such estate to be
 equally divided between my beloved wife Elizabeth Duttraw
 & my two young daughters Catharina Duttraw & Barbara
 Duttraw so as each of them have a equal share - & my wife
 Elizabeth to have her living & residue at this my dwelling
 house during her continuancy as my widow & when
 the true appraisement is ascertained of my personal estate
 divided as above, it is my express will & intention, that
 my son Jacob Duttraw, who have this my dwelling plan-
 tation to pay to my daughter Elizabeth Duttraw as
 much money at the age of eighteen years as the appraised
 value of either of my other daughters share. And also all
 the plantation & carpenter tools, to be equally divided
 between my two sons Jacob & David in the like manner
 as above & no other part of my personal estate. And
 lastly I do hereby constitute, ordain, & appoint my
 wife Elizabeth Duttraw, & my son Jacob Duttraw my
 whole sole executors to this my last will & testament
 revoking & making void all wills & bequests, heretofore
