In the name of God Amen, I Peter Casper of the County of Rowan and State of North Carolina being weak and frail of Body, but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for it and all other of his mercies, and calling to mind the Mortality of my body and that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament (W^{ill}) Principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it, and my body to the Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors, nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again, by

at the general Resurrection, through the mighty
 power of God; and as touching these worldly goods
 wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this
 life, I give devise and dispose of them in manner
 and form as followeth (To) I give and bequeath
 unto my beloved Wife (Ann Mary) privilege of
 sufficient Board for her and her necessary atten-
 dants in my dwelling house and privilege of the barn
 and Milk house, and yearly or each year she shall
 have thirty Bushels of Wheat and forty Bushels of
 Indian Corn, three hundred pounds weight of pot-
 and five gallons of Liquor and three Cows and a kifer
 kept Summer and Winter with as many of their
 Offspring as she shall think proper to raise, and also
 One Horse Horse kept Summer and Winter, and also
 she is to have full privilege of the garden, and also
 to have one acre of Flax sown in good ground
 all which services shall be done for her by my two
 Sons Henry, and Adam, at their own cost and charges
 yearly and each year during the time of her natu-
 ral life. Also I give and bequeath unto my
 said Wife (Ann Mary) all and singular my goods
 and Chattels, Rights and franchises whatsoever

except such as shall be hereafter named mention-
 ed in this my Will As legacies to my Children
 Also I give and bequeath unto the heirs of my late
 Cousin died the sum of Ten pounds to be equally divided
 among them of his Children that shall live to arrive
 at the Years of Maturity, at which time it shall
 become due unto them, and is to be paid in Gold
 or Cash price, also I give and bequeath unto my
 son John my plantation of Land that he now lies
 on containing One hundred Acres of Land, and one
 Waggon which is now in his possession, and Two
 pounds in Money, and one third part of all my body
 Cloths, and I do hereby confirm unto him, all gifts
 that I have given unto him hitherto, also I give and
 bequeath unto my son Henry, one equal half of my
 plantation of Land I now live on and one half the sto-
 =stock of my Waggon I now have in possession, and
 one half the Mall Rings and Widges, and one shot
 Gun one pair of Sling-bells and gears for two horses
 and one third part of my Body Cloths, and I do hereby
 confirm unto him all former gifts, also I give unto
 my Daughter Eve, One Black Mare, One Doe, and
 one Bitch one Brass Kettle, his bed and furniture

My best Chest, One Iron flat, One spinning wheel, and
 One Cow, and I do hereby confirm unto her all former
 gifts, Also I give and bequeath unto my Son Adam
 one equal half of my Plantations now live on, and
 one half of my last mentioned Waggon, One Million
 Horse, and one Brown horse with a Star, two Axes &
 one Mattack, One Rifle gun, One Cow, One half of the
 Millrings and Widges, one plough and all necessary
 Tackling thereunto, Years for two horses, One Iron
 flat, and one third part of my body Cloths, and I
 do hereby confirm unto him all former gifts, and
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my son John
 Cooper and Robert Lynn, Executors of this my last
 Will and Testament, And I do hereby disannul
 and make void all other Wills, Testaments and bequest
 this and no other to be my last Will and Testament
