 and Form following First to my dearly beloved Wife Elizabeth I allow that
 she shall have her living on the Plantation I now live upon without
 any Interruption during the time of her Widowhood except she with the Con-
 sent of my Family should see Cause to dispose of the Plantation. Also
 one Jaral Meas & Colt alias if she should see Cause to Marry then to have
 her thirds as the Law directs Also to John Fleming my eldest son I allow
 that he should have one Share & a half of the Meas and his Colt also one
 Cow & Spinning before and his Gun & a of any before Also I allow for
 the Use of the Plantation as his Right or riding Horse also I give
 my dear Daughter I allow that she shall have one young black cow
 years old Meas also the residue of my Estate I allow that it
 shall be sold & equally divided amongst the whole Family
 except six shoules apiece to each of my three youngest sons
 over and then equal part for their feeding Also I do hereby con-
 -stitute & appoint Elizabeth my Wife & John her son as my Executors
 of this my last Will & Testament and I do hereby revoke all
 Wills and Testaments in former bequests and Wills & Legacies
 by me written in any wise left or made declaring ratifying
 and confirming this to be my last Will and Testament
 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this
 fourth Day of November one thousand seven hundred & sixtieth.

 Labourer, I being very weak in Body but of perfect Mind & Memory
 Thanks be given to God therefore calling to mind the shortness of my Days
 and knowing that it is once appointed for all men to die I do make this
 and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to say principally
 and first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God
 that gave it & for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be buried
 in a Christian like Manner at the Discretion of my Executors nothing
 doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again
 by the Almighty Power of God And as touching such worldly Estate
 wherewith it hath pleased God to bless in this Life with I give devise
 and dispose of the same in the following Manner & Form that is to say
 First I do give will & bequeath to my son John Jacob Frazer son of Shilling & a
 pence. Secondly I do give will & bequeath to my son Peter Frazer son of Shilling & a
 pence. Thirdly I do give will & bequeath to my Daughter Mary Susan a son
 Shilling & a pence. Fourthly I do give will & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth
 a son Shilling & a pence. Fifthly I do give will & bequeath to my
 Daughter Margaret a son Shilling & a pence. Sixthly I do give will &
 bequeath to my son George Frazer a son Shilling & a pence. Seventhly
 I do give will & bequeath to my Daughter Susan a son Shilling & a pence.
 Eighthly I do give will & bequeath to my son Philip Jacob Frazer whom I
 likewise constitute make & ordain my only son & Executor of
 this my last Will & Testament all the residue of the Estate I bequeath
 to him his heirs & assigns for ever And I do hereby utterly revoke all
 and disannul all and every other former Testament or Wills
 made by me in any wise named before this Time with the intention of
 ratifying and confirming this to be my last Will & Testament and I do hereby
 to pay to my Executors the several legacies therein named and I do hereby
 shall live in witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this
