of land to be laid on that side the Landon Da-
mon's Creek to him or his Heirs for ever and
if case that either my above mentioned Sons Charles
Glascock and Moses Glascock should die before

bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Glascock
all the remainder of my Negroes Harry
Grace Joe George Thos & Hannah also
all my stock and the remainder of the Estate
During her natural life and at her decease
to be Equally divided among my Children here
after mentioned that is to say Peter Glascock
Charles Glascock Mosey Glascock
Margaret Glascock except the Negro Man named
Joe which I give and bequeath to my son Spencer
Glascock at the death of his Mother. Item I give
and bequeath to my beloved Son John Glascock
