Will and Testament give and dispose of in the
manner and form following that is to say
First of all I give and bequeath to my beloved wife
Mary Glascock One hundred and Twenty Acres of
Land where I now live Including the Plantation dur-
ing her natural life and at her death to fall to my
beloved son James Glascock to him and his heirs
forever I give and bequeath to my beloved son
Charles Glascock One hundred Acres of Land part of
the same Tract I live on to be laid off on that side
of the land adjoining Cedar Creek to him and his
heirs forever, I also give and bequeath to my
beloved son Moses Glascock One hundred Acres
of land to be laid off on that side the land on Cedar
Creek to him or his heirs forever and
if case that either my above mentioned sons Charles
Glascock and Moses Glascock should die before

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Before they Arrive to the age of Twenty One Years do or
now have any heir lawfully begotten, then at their
deaths or either of them the above Land mentioned for them
to fall to my beloved Son William Glascock & Whiston Glas-
cock to them and their heirs forever. ~~Item~~ I give and
bequeath to my beloved Son William Glascock Whiston
Glascock & Elijah Glascock the three following Negroes
James Charles and Henry to be equally divided between
them at Time they Arrive to the age of Twenty Years

bequeath to my beloved Son Spencer Glascock
a Negroe Boy named Caleb. I also give and
bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Glascock
all the remainder of my Negroes Harry
Grace Joe George Thoslor & Hannah also
all my stock and the remainder of the Estate
During her natural life and at her decease
to be Equally divided amongst my Children herein
after mentioned that is to say Peter Glascock
Charles Glascock Moses Glascock
Margaret Glascock except the Negro Man named
Tod which I give and bequeath to my Son Spencer
Glascock at the death of his Mother. ~~Item~~ I give
and bequeath to my beloved Son John Glascock

I also give to my beloved Sons and Daughters
Gregory Glascock Sarah Collins, James Glascock
Jesse Glascock Sam Ricks Francis (Dulon & Eliza-

(and making void any Will or Wills heretofore by
me made and Ratifying and Confirming &
Acknowledging this to be my last Will and Tes-
