say principally and first of all I gave and recommend my soul into y^e
Hands of almighty God that gave all and for my Body I recommend it
to y^e Earth to be buried in a Christian like and decent Manner at y^e
Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the general Resurrec-
tion I shall receive y^e same again by y^e mighty Power of God. And as
touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless
me with in this Life I gave likewise Dispose of y^e same in manner
and Terms following that is to say.

In the first place I gave and bequeath to Solomy my dear beloved
Wife whom I likewise constitute make and ordain together with
my loving Brother Charles Hinkle my only and sole Executors
of this my last Will and Testament that is to as appoynt -
To Solomy my Wife cleave to herself her riding Saddle and a certain
Cow that she had from her Father and six Hogs and two Sheeps and
all the Crop of Corn that is growing on y^e plantation this year and
Flax and a certain parcel of Wheat which she is to have & to sup-
port her Children this Winter only she is to let Peter Cooks have
feeding for one Sould this Winter she is also to have her Ox and
breedree that belongs to it. Also I gave to my wife beloved Son
Anthony a certain Bay Mare call'd the Mildown Mare and all
her Incomes except the Child which his Mother is now big with
if please God she live to beget a Boy then he is to have
half the Incomes & if she beget a Girl then she is to have
to have the whole Incomes & if she beget a Girl then she is to have the

is on a certain Survey of Land which was run out for
me and my Brother Charles by Henry Davis and I allow
it to be divided between Charles and my Son as it was then
agreed to be divided between Charles and me. I also gave to my
unbeloved Daughter Mary a certain Rafter that came from that
Cow that I have left to my Wife but if the Child that is affor-
mentioned should be a girl then she is to have half the Greaves
of that Rafter. Also I gave to my Cousin Peter Cooper a certain
bay Horse Collar that came of the above Milhorn Mass and
all my wearing Cloths. And as for the Reminding part of
my Estate after my just Debts be paid to be divided the third
part to my Wife and the Remainder to be divided equally be-
tween my Children and when divided the part allowed to my Son
or Sons to be put out to Entrust to chase out the land out of
the Office And it is my desire that my Children be under the
Care of my Executors and not bound out but by their Consent.
And to hereby utterly revoke and void all and every other
former Testaments Wills and Legacies Bequests and Executors by me
in any Ways before this time made willed and bequeathed ra-
tifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will

Secondly, I give and bequeath to Margret my nearly beloved Daughter
one Cow and Calf, and five pounds prack. Thirdly I give and bequeath
to Thomas my nearly beloved Son the Black Mare of that year &c.
also one Cow and Calf, my estate boat and five pounds prack more.
Fourthly, I give and bequeath to Miriam my nearly beloved Son
blue Coat, and Jacket, also a pair of black breeches, one Cow and Calf
five pounds prack. Fifthly I give and bequeath to Mary my
Sister Dying
