That is to say principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul unto the hand of allmighty God who give it. And my body I recommend to the earth; to be buried in a decent manner at the direction of my executors, nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise & dispose of the same in following manner & form. First I give & bequeath to Jacob Lumy my beloved son my waggon and all the gears with all my working tools that I possess besides his part with the rest of my heirs. Also I give and bequeath to the others to have even part one like the other and my beloved wife shall have her child's part like the rest of my heirs as to be divided to equal part. Also the two hundred acres of land that lyes on the waters of Lige creek shall be divided among them and if they can not agree they may sell it and divide it. Also all my just debts to the paid first and then they shall divide and take their share & by them freely to be possessed & enjoyed. And I do hereby utterly disallow

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and revoke and disannul all and every other former testament wills, legacies, bequest, & executors by me in any ways before named. with & bequeath, ratify and confirming this an no other, to be my last will & testament. Lastly I make ordain and pronounce Peter Lumy and George Lumy and Frederick Lumy my beloved sons to be my executors after me. In witness where I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty third day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and four.
