This 15th day of August 1782 I Samuel Hillhouse of the County & town ship Rowan former being very sick & weak in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God caling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make this my last will & Testament that is to say principally & first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of God that giveth and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching our worldly Estate ~~in~~ where with it hath pleased god to bless me with in this life I give devise & dispose of the same in the following manner & form. First I give & bequeath to my dear & beloved wife three Cows & her mare & saddle & all the decussor furniture the Beds her bed & bed clothes and spinning wheel and her maintenance of the Land her life time. Secondly I leave & bequeath to my loving Son Sampson the third of the land the plow & plow Irons malle & wedges and one Cow. Thirdly I leave & bequeath unto my Loving Son Robert the third of the land he now lives on. fourthly I leave & bequeath unto my loving son Samuel this third of the land I now live on with houses & improvements and three Cows & his mare & colt. fifthly I leave & bequeath to my loving Daughter Ann one white mare sixthly I leave & bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth her mare & saddle & three Cows & her bed & furniture

Seventhly I leave & bequeath unto my Daughter Martha five shillings hard money. Lastly I leave my loving wife Hillhouse and Ja^s. Martin to be my whole Executors of this my last will & Testament to them fully to be disposed of the Legacies & I do utterly revoke & disannul all every other former testaments wills legacies bequests & Executors by me in any wife before named willed and bequeathed ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 16th day of August in the year of our lord one thousand seven hundred & eighty two signed sealed & published pronounced & declared by me Samuel Hillhouse my last will & Testament in the presence of us in his presence & in the presence of each other have herto subscribed our names
