

I give, devise, & dispose of the same in manner & form following that is to say.

I give & bequeath unto My daughter Mary Hunter wife of Frederick Hunter to her, her heirs & assigns, one black mare & yearling colt one red grad cow one black huffed eight years of twelve hundred linnen that much of my estate & no more.

Likewise I give & bequeath to my two beloved grandsons to wit William & Charles Hunter one hundred & fifty acres of land to be sold by my executors & the money paid to interest till the youngest brother is twenty one years of age, then to be equally divided between the two brothers; the said land to be laid off on the west end of the tract I now live on joining James Rathge Thos. Sumner, James Taylor, & Will^m. Howard, on the west side of Johannes Branch to be laid off by a north & south line a cross the tract. that much of my estate & no more.

Lastly I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane Patterson (after my just debts & funeral charges is paid) the remaindes of my tract of land, with all the improvements, likewise all the remaindes of my estate both real & personal, to her, her heirs & assigns forever. Do hereby appoint my two friends Thos. Rathge & John Brandon, my executors of this my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal.

In the name of God Amen! I Richard Vack of the County of Rowan & State of N^c. Carolina, being of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for the same Do this 21st Day of January A^d 1804 make & ordain this my last will & test. in order & form as followeth (Wiz)

Item I give & bequeath unto my son James Vack one hundred acres of land lying & joining Martin Schaffers & Will^m. Howard John Dowe's tract of land ~~also the land there above bequeathed to my son James Vack~~ on condition my son John Vack pays twenty four Dollars to be equally divided between my six daughters at or before my daughter Nancy is or would be of age.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son John Vack one hundred acres of land lying joining Jacob Meetses & W^m. Howard, & also the land there above bequeathed to my son James Vack on condition my son John Vack pays twenty five Dollars to be equally divided between my six daughters at or before the day when my daughter Nancy would be of age.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Vack all the remainings of the tract of land I purchased of John Johnson after my sons James Vacks one hundred, & my son John Vacks one hundred acres are laid off as above bequeathed unto them; my son James & John.

Item I bind unto my beloved wife Mary Vack the plantation with all the land belonging to the tract I now live on during her natural life.

Item I also bind unto my beloved wife Mary Vack all my stock of horses cattle & hogs & also all my stock of sheep & also all my household furniture & kitchen furniture &

& all my tools of all kinds, plough & gears & every article belonging to me, on the plantation at my decease to her during her natural life

Item, After the decease of my wife Mary Pack I give & bequeath to my son Will^m Pack the plantation & tract of land whereon I now live, which I above lend to my wife during her widowhood or natural life, It is my will & desire that my son Thomas Pack & Will^m Pack should have the privilege of raising each one horse on the plantation I now live on & it is also my will & desire that my son Thomas & Will^m should be furnished each with a good saddle & if they should fail to rise them a horse, while living on the plantation before they come of age, that my executors should rise them a horse & saddle each of them, when each one comes of age out of the stock or property lend to my beloved wife her natural life. After my beloved wife decease I give & bequeath unto my six Daughters, Susanna, Elizabeth, Rebecca, Jean, Mary & Anne, all my stock of horses cattle, hogs, & sheeps & all & every article except the land which I lend to my beloved wife her natural life; each one share & share alike, It is also my will & desire should either of my sons James & John, Thomas or Will^m die without a lawfull heir begotten of their body, all I have given them should be equally divided between my afore mentioned six Daughters, it is also my will & desire should either of my Daughters receive any part of the property before the decease of my wife by my wife's consent, that whatsoever other of my six Daughters should receive of my wife should be considered.

as a part of their portion to be divided at my beloved wife's death I appoint my beloved wife Mary Pack & my son James Pack & my son John Pack executors to this my last will & test, In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand, & seal the day & year above mentioned.
